

# Are You Hungry to be Actualized for the Kingdom?

Recently our Community received a very important revelatory teaching on 'Hunger'.<sup>1</sup> To summarize the important point, it's this:

- **Holy Spirit moves in proportion to our hunger for the things of the Kingdom**

If a person wants to progress in any spiritual area of the Kingdom, their absolute hunger (desperation) is an indication of their faith level and also the level of their trust that what they want can be supplied. This is a catalyst for the Spirit to work.

'Hunger' is an important principle that we must inculcate, allowing it to be part of our maturation process.

Of course we can greatly desire and hunger after things that are mistaken – religious, legal or misplaced. These are not within the category that this principle covers. For example: We can greatly desire or hunger for revival. But if our understanding of revival is not aligned with our King's current position<sup>2</sup> on this phenomenon, then we are 'out of line' and can't expect to get our hunger satisfied. (We need to become fit vessel ourselves to hold any revival, not just desire it.)

If we only hunger after righteousness because the Bible states that we are to “hunger and thirst after righteousness”<sup>3</sup> then we'll never grow and mature properly. We'll be stuck in the 'fight' to remain righteous and the many other important facets of the Kingdom will be overlooked. [Actually, Jesus didn't state that we are to hunger and thirst after righteousness. He taught that those who do will have their desire met.]

If we are to individually mature as sons of the Kingdom, then we need to **hunger** after such things as these:

1. To operate as a fully-fledged Kingdom citizen
2. To operate as a fully-fledged son
3. To manifest sonship
4. To be about Father's business
5. To partner with heaven as an apprentice to the King
6. To grow and mature spiritually
7. To prepare to spiritually parent others
8. To learn how to mentor in preparation
9. To leave all religion and legalism behind
10. To learn all there is to know about the Kingdom
11. To hear accurately in the spirit
12. To be taught by revelation as your main source of learning
13. To share your revelations and testimonies
14. To know your destiny scroll
15. To enter your Kingdom destiny
16. To bring prodigals back to father
17. To see those in the spiritual wilderness come into community
18. To start a Kingdom Community in your own street

Our task as sons is to be about Father's business and to complete our Kingdom assignments. It's not about any of our desires to please ourselves or to be idle.

The items itemised above are just the beginning of a long list that is essential for Kingdom citizens to take their part in the Kingdom. Every national citizen has a part to play in their country and the goal for each of them should be to be the best, most productive citizen that we can become – for the good of the nation. The Kingdom is no different this way.

**A word of caution:** Each time we balk at what the Spirit is wanting us to do, it's usually because we justify why we shouldn't do what we are instructed. Doing this regularly over time leads to a dulling in hearing the Spirit's voice, which means we reduce our effectiveness in the Kingdom. We need to 'jump in' like a little child<sup>4</sup>, full of enthusiasm, when the Spirit gives us an instruction to perform a task.

A fully functioning Kingdom son is a fully actualized person, so start getting hunger for all the things of the Kingdom.
