

Being, Not Doing

I was given the revelation in November 2016: “It's about being, not doing”.

Here's the confirmation I received in December of that year:

“The glory will never be 'back unto God' if it's not conception first – must be conceived by God. As the Lord's showed me numbers of times, “I don't appreciate what I don't initiate”. He's told me that over and over, because I'm guilty...It's best to wait on the Lord. We, sometimes are pushed, because we feel...barren. I mean it in this way: we feel like, “Shouldn't I be doing something?” And there is the great trap. “Shouldn't I be doing?” Note this about man: man's substitute for reality with God and the leading of God is to want to do something. That's a substitute. To do, do. Rather than God doing, we suddenly feel like, “I need to do something”.¹

That's such an important statement by Terry Bennett. It goes against everything our culture teaches us and what church groups desire for their adherents.

Our only responsibility is to do and say what the Spirit tells us – nothing more. We are driven by the religious spirit and also be the spirit of distraction to do, do, do. This, however, has it's origin in our soul and so has no eternal or Kingdom value.
