




The 2010 Christmas Questions & Answers

- ◆ It is one of the major teachings in the bible by Jesus himself.




Q2. What exactly does Heaven on Earth mean?

- ◆ It literally means exactly what it says. Q3. What is Jesus' role when He comes and what will He look like?

Q4. Does the rapture of the Saints occur before or after the Great tribulation?

- ◆ There is enough confirmation in scripture to make a convincing argument that the rapture of the

Saints comes after the great tribulation. Dan 7:25 talks about 'He (the anti-Christ) shall speak pompous words against the most high (Jesus) and shall persecute the saints of the most High. Rev 13:7 says 'and it was granted to him (the anti-Christ) to make war against the Saints.' Both references indicate that the Saints are on earth in the same time period as the anti-Christ, so the Saints have not been raptured before the great tribulation. You may think the rapture occurs before and that is fine with me.

Q5. What happens to those left on earth when Jesus comes?

- ◆ Firstly, there will be the resurrected saints that return with Him; secondly, those with the mark of the beast (anti-Christ) who did not die in the initial battles or were somewhere else on the earth; and thirdly the resisters (those who made no choice for Jesus or the beast). Those with the mark of the beast will be dealt with first. Trials will occur and some will be executed. The saints will work with the 3rd group called the resisters. Initially it will be much the same as now, except the governments of the countries will in time be ruled by righteous leaders. There will be a lot of mess and reconstruction needed. No unemployment!
