

Reprogramming Our Theology

These are the notes from the video clip¹ I produced with the same title:

- It's not enough to come out of the church system.
- Our belief system – our theology – has to change as well.
- If we still believe what we did before, we are not going to be effective for the Kingdom.
- What we believe now has come from these 2 sources:
 - The Bible (*the word of God?*)
 - Preaching/Teaching (*the word of God?*)
- That is how we built our personal theology (i.e. what we believe about God and his Kingdom).
- Father needs to thwart our attempt at understanding his Kingdom.
- Just as Jesus of Nazareth did, religious mindsets must be realigned with the Kingdom.
- He must completely destroy our theology and rebuild it fro our own good.
- Much to our annoyance.
- He doesn't include much of what we used to believe.
- There's too much important information to know.
- He does all this reprogramming personally.
- The Spirit of Truth teaches us personally – if we'll let him.
- You probably realise now that you wasted a lot of time in the past

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- We must focus on The Word of God himself², not other 'the word of God'.
- He is the one who is the source of all knowledge, not men and their theologies.
- The process of reprogramming must be submitted to. You will not be reprogrammed unless you desire it and ask for it.
- Reprogramming takes years, so don't be in a hurry.
- Allow yourself to be reprogrammed at the slow pace you are able to cope with the changes.
- Reprogramming will bring spiritual maturity beyond the level of your peers – and even the religious leaders of your day.
