

The Difference Between Reality and Truth

It may be hard to understand the difference between what is a person's truth and what is reality, so here's a simple example exercise:

QUESTION #1: What direction does the sun rise in?

ANSWER: An easterly direction, not the East.

A person might have been taught that it rises in the East and they can argue as much as they like, because it's a truth to them, but they are dead wrong. The reality is that it depends in the season and the latitude of the location as to exactly where the sun rises in the morning.

Here's the directions for Canberra at the winter solstice. See the yellow line and compare it with the compass rose on the map.



QUESTION #2: Whereabouts is the sun located at midday?

ANSWER: No necessarily overhead.

A person may have been taught that it is overhead at midday, but that's just the truth they've assented to. The reality is that it depends in the season and the latitude of the location as to exactly where the sun is at midday.

Check the photo over the page of the midday position of the sun in Alaska on a winter's day – it's just about the horizon. In fact, it completely disappears during the day in mid winter in the North Pole area.



QUESTION #3: Where does a directional compass point to?

ANSWER: A northerly direction.

A person may have been taught that it points north, but in reality it points to the North Magnetic Pole, not North Pole. The North Pole is a fixed geographical location, however, the North Magnetic Pole moves. Check this map which shows the North Magnetic Pole's positions since 1600. Currently it's in Siberia:¹

In the Kingdom, we need to know the reality, not the 'truths' we've learnt from the church system or from preachers.
