

Transformed by the Spirit of the Lord

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As we are entering the age of the kingdom, dramatic and extreme changes will cause many people including many Christians to search for answers and relief. Distressed souls will cry out, "Where is truth? Where is our help? Where is noble strong leadership? Regret and remorse will move many to deep repentance and turning to God. Others will blame God for their troubled state and speak evil of Him to their own end.

At the same time, many pure hearted holy people of God will be engulfed in the presence of His glory manifesting among them, along with many holy angels.

There will be no middle ground and no place for moderation. There will be deep and sometimes painful separation between those who abide in God and those who do not. The sheep are being separated from the goats. The parable of the sheep and the goats is not just about some distant future work of Christ Jesus.

Matthew 25: 32-34, 41 – *All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats. And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world... Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me...'"*

In this parable, the sheep had love abiding within them that caused them to provide for the needs of the least of the people of God. The goats' lack of love was evidenced in that they did not provide for the needs of God's people. The sheep entered into the kingdom, and the goats did not.

The most powerful force for change is perfect love, the pure holy love of God.

1 Corinthians 2: 4-5 – *And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.*

1 Corinthians 4:20 – *For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power.*

Miracles

One of the most encouraging things that God does for us is to cause us to experience firsthand His miracle working power. It is always exciting when God moves in a way that cannot be reasonably denied or explained as a natural event. We feel more alive and in love with him as we walk together with Him and watch His works taking place before us. It is great to read again and again of His extraordinary miraculous works in the Bible. Yet they may seem a bit removed until we witness His miracle working power in and among us today.

There are large miracles involving numbers of people and significant world events. And there are seemingly less important manifestations or miracles of a smaller and more personal nature. Some may seem almost trivial to some people. Yet the personal encouragement is of great value to the people experiencing or witnessing them. Spiritual manifestations can be a great personal delight simply by letting us know that God is mindful of us and cares about us.

The most significant use and reason for many miracles and manifestations is to witness to unbelievers. Many religious people are unbelievers when it comes to the personal involvement with God in their lives. Experiencing one truly miraculous supernatural event can change the mindset of a person that could not be changed by words alone.

The love and power of God in Christ Jesus by the Holy Spirit is the only potential for changing our world to the kingdom of God. The kingdom of God is not in word alone, but in the expressed love and power of God within His many sons by the Holy Ghost of Christ Jesus.

Beneath the darkness of the purifying cleansing judgments of the night season, the seed of the glorious kingdom life is growing in the hearts and lives of His people to break through in the light of the morning of the Day of His glory.
