


Your Resistance to Reprogramming for the Kingdom

To move ahead in the Kingdom you must relinquish everything you believe from the religious system and allow Holy Spirit to correct, confirm, reteach and reprogram you.


That decision will put you 'at odds' with Christendom.



To get your mind thinking about 'truth', let me ask you a science question: How many colours are in the spectrum of white light?

The spectrum is what we see in a rainbow if you've forgotten your high school lessons.

Seven colours? Well, that's what you've been taught. These colours:¹





In reality, there are an infinite lot of colours in the visible spectrum.

Don't believe me? Check out the graphic on the right.

This shows an expanded view of the spectrum from a prism.²

So, looking closely, here's the full spectrum of what we call visible (white) light.³



Notice the numbers up the top. These are the frequencies of the light at those points.

NOTE: Infra-red wavelengths and ultra-violet wavelengths are on either side of the spectrum.

You see, in one form, visible light is many waves just like radio waves and microwaves. Light waves from the sun don't come in bands, they come in all the possible frequencies.

Each frequency received by the eye is interpreted by the brain as a different colour. However, we only notice the big shifts in colour, not the minuscule changes. Hence, we group the colours to make it easy for us to talk about.

Were you taught at school that there are 7 colours? That's because people in past centuries wanted to approach life on earth from a Christian perspective, so they shifted the number of colours from 6 to 7 to make it align with the 7 days of creation – just like seven days in the week and 7 notes in a musical scale. This of course is a religious thing to do. In fact, there really isn't a colour indigo in the spectrum.⁴

Do you get the idea?

What you've been taught stays with you because you believe what your teachers teach you.

It's the same in the churches. Everyone believes what they are taught – especially if Bible references are used. We are programmed to do this – without questioning.

It's good to question things. Why? Because everyone has an agenda that they want others to adhere to.

Don't believe me?

Do you know that what you were taught in high school about the function and structure of the atom is not completely true?

If you did science at university, you have to be retaught about the atom. It comes as a bit of a shock to realise that you weren't taught the truth when your science teacher indoctrinated you at school that science is all about the truth.

Did you know that what atomic physicists are discovering about the atom right now, completely blows away even what university might teach you about atoms.

Same with light. What quantum physicists are discovering about light is so 'weird' that your high school science seems like a lie.

Don't believe me? You won't be able to read physicist's text books and journal articles because they will be indecipherable to most people. However, Phil Mason (New Earth Tribe Christian community, Byron Bay, NSW) has written a simplified book on light and the atom that even [physicists have stated is easy for the general public to read. It's titled, "Quantum Glory"⁵.

Now back to my topic.

Do you realise that what makes up your theology is what you've been taught in church, bible study, conferences and teaching books? Theological college, seminary or Bible school won't help you either because they only propagate what they've been taught – that's normal for schools.

The reason why there are denominations is because they adhere to certain teachings that they believe others don't believe. They even regard other denominations – whether stated or not – as heretics or in error.

This should not be the case. We should all have the same theology as we are following the same divine being – the Trinity. That will be of course only if you believe in the Trinity.

Let me cut to the chase: We normally only believe what we've been taught or read. There are a few

radicals who dare to allow the Spirit to teach them⁶ just like Jesus said he would. They discover more of the truth that heaven has for us.

There are few of these because those who don't adhere to the 'doctrines' of the group they belong to are ostracised. Just read John Crowder's book 'New Mystics'⁷ to get a historic perspective on my statement.

I'm not trying to be rebellious in what I'm saying. I'm just wanting you to see that what we have been taught doesn't always align with Heavenly truth.

Even so, we are usually adamant that what we believe is the truth – until Holy Spirit upsets your 'apple cart' with a real truth. Then, once you are rocked, you come to the realisation that Jesus has to teach you his truth through his Spirit, just like he said he would.⁸

Let's check some out some beliefs, 'for argument sake'. Read these articles:

See what I mean? Not everything we've been taught by Bible teachers or from the pulpit is accurate.

Are you a Millennial Reign proponent, or are you not?

Christians hold their views on End Times very strongly, disagreeing mostly with those who differ.

Did you know that almost all of what is understood as End Time theology is biblical interpretation? That's why there are so many different versions.

You're most likely familiar with the Futurist view because that's what's been taught since Scofield's Reference Bible of the early 1900's. It's propagated by Tim LaHeye's books and countless other speakers and writers.

Check out my summary of the Historist view of the book of Revelation.¹⁷ You won't know if your theory (interpretation) of Revelation is accurate until you understand what others see in it.

Previously, we looked at the 20 verses in Revelation that are troublesome to the Futurist's eschatology.¹⁸ Yet with all these difficulties, those who subscribe to that theology have no trouble in dismissing them or fancifully explaining them away.

So why do they stick with their 'pet' theory (interpretation)? Do they choose to? Or do they not know any other theory (interpretation) of Revelation?

REMEMBER: Biblical interpretation is a matter of what 'glasses' you read with.

So what's the truth about End Times? That will only be revealed when it transpires, because we have no idea of what Father's plans are.

That is of course, unless you ask him (or Jesus) questions and get his answers.

Anything else is pure speculation, no matter how many Bible verses you can back it up with.

WE DO NOT KNOW the full truth about End Times.

This is why I've been giving you insight into the different eschatologies. This should cause you to hold your views very lightly and be prepared to have them changed.

I don't want to change your views. That's Holy Spirit's job. However, he can't do that unless you hold all your theology as transient (not permanent) because we just don't know everything.
