

Sowing and Reaping is a Spiritual Law

The law of sowing and reaping has its foundation in the OC. However, it was not a Torah law of the Jews and is not relevant in the NC as a Law. It's a spiritual law, not a religious law, so we must bear it in mind all the time because it's in-play right now, in the 21st century.

Here's a reminder from the Throne of the King in case it has slipped your mind:

*“The winds of change are blowing. For those who have made Me their first love, the changes will be positive and fruitful. But for others who have shaken their fists, the changes will only bring more difficulties and stress. **Sowing and reaping is a spiritual law, which cannot be broken.** What you give, whether good or bad, will come back to you multiplied.”*¹

Even though the blood sacrifice of Father's perfect Son paid the price for so much, there are still things that we are to take responsibility for. For example: It's one thing to know that all sin is covered under the blood, but we shouldn't continue to sin, taking advantage of that fact. That's called 'foolishness' or 'presumption', as I've taught on before.²

We were originally created to be the King's vicegerents³ on Earth, to manage the planet and be responsible to the Trinity for our actions. Now that we're back in Father's family, this role has been reactivated. It was never really lost in The Fall, it was corrupted. We were given autonomy, unlike the angels, and we're therefore responsible for our actions. Why do you think there is a judgement at the end of our lives, sometime?

Because the enemy is still corrupting people as well as the natural realm, we are tempted to do things that are out of alignment with Heaven. This is what 'sin' is.⁴ Therefore, there are consequences in the natural and spiritual when we do sin. These consequences come because we give the enemy an open door to do what he wants to do. That always leads to chaos and mayhem. The Blood doesn't cover these repercussions because we were created to take responsibility for our actions.

*“Agitation is a weapon formed against you to get you off track, but you can bind the power of that weapon and maintain your peace if you will take the time to do so. Actively resist the temptations that come to express anger or impatience, and they will pass quickly. However, **if you act on the irritation that you feel, it will lead to unpleasant consequences.** As you continue to maintain self-control you will gain spiritual freedom, says the Lord.”*⁵

The buck stops with each of us.
