

# Use Every Situation To Your Spiritual Advantage

As humans we tend to complain about our life and our circumstances. However, this behaviour has no place in the Kingdom.

If we know our King is already on the throne<sup>1</sup> and he's supervising our lives for his purposes, then we must see everything that happens from a Kingdom perspective – his perspective.

It's a reality that we have to align with him, and rule over our own kingdom in accordance with his oversight. It's also a reality that, as kings, we are responsible to prevent the enemy from usurping control over any area of our life and our kingdom.

These realities being the case, we are accountable for everything that goes 'kibosh' around us. However, the enemy has assignments that are granted to him from deliberations within Divine Council, so we can expect attacks and negative situations to materialise at any moment. These we may not have much control over, but we do have control over our attitude<sup>2</sup> towards them.

The appropriate attitude is to check with Holy Spirit to find out how to function in each situation and to find out how it can be turned to our advantage. While ever we have the King's 'ear' we can tell him that we're looking to him to bring something positive out of each negative situation when it appears. It's important to have the correct attitude with life's experiences: He's always positive.

Here's his recent reminder to operate this way:

*“Develop an attitude of patient endurance in these times of suffering. You have indeed endured times of difficulty and unpleasantness. But, just as I (your Lord) suffered to eradicate sin, you can use your current suffering to overcome the carnal nature and become a better person. Do not despise these days, but rather use every situation to your spiritual advantage.”<sup>3</sup>*
