

# Our Dependence on Prophecy Must Change

The Charismatic and Pentecostal movements have become lazy – at least that’s my observation. There’s too much emphasis on the ‘professional’ doing things for the believer. The prayer warrior, the pastor, the prophet, the prayer team member, etc. These are the ones who are called upon when there’s a need.

That isn’t scriptural and it’s not the way the Kingdom functions.

Primarily the Kingdom is about sons in relationship with the members of the Trinity as they work to expand the Kingdom of Heaven on the Earth. This is done as an apprenticeship with the King and works on a one-to-one basis. Things happen slightly differently when we gather corporately, however, the main idea is that our personal relationship with the Trinity is the source of all our needs. ‘Professionals’ in the Christian religion are for the “babes”, the immature.

Sons work at a different level. Sons hear for themselves. Sons don’t need prophecy, except in the area of what the King is doing in the Community, the nation and the world. This is where apostles and prophets come into play. This is also where we share our individual revelations so we can piece together our King’s intent for our community, etc.

I concur with Mike Parsons that we need to train ourselves as maturing sons to cease depending on those with a prophetic mantle. Mike said recently:

*“In reality, people need to really view what trust they put into prophetic ministry because I think it's an old order which, really, people need to start weaning themselves off and start listening to God themselves to find out what God is doing in their own lives and what they can do to cooperate with what he's doing, not oppose it. You know, and I think that that requires discernment to not oppose and to have a bigger picture agenda and not just simplify it or see it simplistically.”<sup>1</sup>*
