The Second Harbinger: The Terrorist

By the dawn of the first millennium B.C. they had begun their rise to power and soon most of the ancient middle east was under their rule. They were a militaristic people. They devised new technologies of warfare. Their empire was a war machine. They were among the most brutal people ever to have walked the earth.
