

HOW TO: Handle Teaching

We are to listen with our mind and our spirit when we are in a teaching situation.

While listening, you must actively discern what is being presented to you. You must not be docile, accepting any teaching.

When teaching is not feeding your spirit and does not contain sound doctrine which the Spirit shows you that you need at the moment, shut it down – turn it off, leave the room, put the book away, don't go to the conference, etc.

Here's some dodgy teaching to watch out for:

1. Lacking spiritual content
2. No spiritual food (rhema)
3. Emotionally manipulating speaker
4. Error proposed
5. Religious or legalistic content
6. Religious or legalistic speaker
7. Constant Bible quoting
8. Quoting other people's error
9. What the Lord has taught you is obsolete or wrong
