



Did you get that?


Father is wanting to teach his genuine sons about the mysteries that he's kept locked up for millennia. These are received by revelation, not theology.

'Doctrine' translated from the Greek didaskalia means 'teaching'. So, yes, there will be new things we'll need to teach each other – like "Father's Heart".






Following are 3 videos of interviews with Michael Heiser. They give you an understanding that the NT Jews better understood the Bible than we do with all our theological investigation and prowess.
