

The Kingdom of God – His Primary Purpose

Kingdom: Statement

For the Kingdom of God to become a reality, God's primary purpose has to be fulfilled. His primary purpose is the reconciliation and joining together of the spiritual realm and the natural realm into one in Christ. Only then can Father dwell with His people face to face.

Ephesians 1:9-10 says "Having made known to us the mystery of His will...that He might gather together in one ALL things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth."

***Ephesians 1:9-10** (AMP) – Making known to us the mystery (secret) of His will (of His plan, of His purpose). [And it is this:] In accordance with His good pleasure (His merciful intention) which He had previously purposed and set forth in Him¹, [He planned] for the maturity of the times and the climax of the ages to unify all things and head them up and consummate them in Christ, [both] things in heaven and things on the earth.*

Said another way: **The centrepiece of God's eternal purpose is for Jesus to come back to fully establish His Kingdom rule and reign over all the Earth as he joins the heavenly and the earthly realm together.**

Understanding God's primary purpose is the **interpretative key** to unlocking an understanding of End Times and many other related scriptures.

Kingdom: Application

God's primary purpose will happen to a greater degree in the Millennial Reign of Christ, which is after the Second Coming, but it will not be fully established until the Eternal Age. As said above, understanding God's primary purpose is the interpretive key to understanding End Times.

This explains why there is such a lack of motivation in the body of Christ to get on with the job of the great commission, which is a demonstration of the Gospel of the Kingdom and making disciples of the nations. **This lack of motivation in the church can be traced back, and directly attributed to, a total failure of understanding God's primary purpose.**

God's personality can only be fully expressed by the two realms coming together. The inclusion of the natural realm is a critical component for this to happen.

God's action plan is a multi-faceted plan, which has not been fully revealed to us yet. The 1,000-Year Reign is only one small part of it, like "one day" is to God². There is much, much more to come, and for us to participate in.

When we come to the realisation that we are going to be back here on this Earth in our supernatural bodies it has the potential to **radically change our view of the future and our view of the present**. This is because our eyes have been opened and we recognise that what we do now is critical because it is linked to what we **could** be doing in the future. Our 70 years here on this Earth is training or serious practice for not only the 1,000 years, but for all eternity.

Kingdom Life: How to live life abundantly

God says we have abundant life now.³ Once we get a grasp of God's primary purpose, or have a paradigm shift to see things from a Kingdom perspective. We can then move into correct alignment with the Lord's will for our lives. This means we will discover more of our individual calling and destiny in him – because we will be connected to the Kingdom. We will be released from 'the work', for 'The Work'.

My Suggestions

- a) Start using your holy imagination and ask God to show you your destiny and give you a portal into Heaven.
- b) Make a start of studying all things pertaining to the Kingdom in End Times. There is a vast amount of good teaching on these many subjects. We are also commanded to know the signs and the times.
- c) Start believing that we are in the End Times and are so privileged to be chosen by God for this closing age. **NB:** No dates are set.
- d) Start studying the 22 rewards Jesus has made available for us. This is not an option because he has commanded us to do so. The rewards will excite you, as he personally reveals these to you.
- e) Continue loving the things of the Earth, especially those he has given you a special love for. But always love him the most and hold everything else loosely. Do not make them idols: but he did make them for us to enjoy.
- f) Realise we have 'The Work' to do for the Kingdom of God to be made manifest on the Earth. Jesus is not coming back till we get our act together individually and corporately.
