There are a number of important points in his talk that need ‘fixing’ so they are accurate:

- The most important thing Jesus did was NOT leaving. In regard to his legacy, it was, but it wasn’t the most important thing he did.
- The most important thing in a relay is NOT passing the baton. Passing the baton is the most critical step in a relay, but winning is the most important thing.
- Reaching the age of 40 is NOT when you should begin to mentor others to replace you. Actually, 40 years of gaining knowledge is the point where mentoring should probably start. If a person is still untrained and immature at age 40, there’s no point in beginning to mentor others.
- The time to begin mentoring and who to mentor is NOT our decision. It requires a go-ahead from the Spirit. In the Kingdom we are always on assignment for the King, not doing our own thing. We must never forget that.
