

Apostolic: Strategy and Warfare

I watched a history movie once, where I saw the general sitting on a high hill watching the battle. He could see both sides fighting and in doing so was able to understand the ways of the enemy's army and got to know the mind of his opponent. He then gathered the leaders of the army and gave them the battle plan. He had complete vision and a perspective of the whole field and could lead them with understanding and wisdom. The important thing was that the leaders of his army followed his instructions and, as long as they did, they never lost a battle. As I saw that, the LORD spoke to me and said, "What you are seeing is symbolic of what the apostolic leaders are to do, the generals of my army. They will sit on the mountain top and get vision, direction, and strategy to help my people advance. The apostolic fathers will lead my people through battles and will bring them to victory. Teach them and prepare them to find strategy for battle." This opened a new dimension of the Kingdom for us, enlarging our vision and giving us tools for the Kingdom to advance."*¹

Apostleship has a heavy weight of responsibility to lead strategically from Heaven. This should be well considered during the growth process towards full apostleship.
