

MESSAGE: Multiculturalism in Australia

(King's Counsel on 11-9-2017)

Question: Lord, what's your mind on multiculturalism¹ in our nation?

Message

Rather than producing harmony in diversity, the experience of history is that it continues to divide nations and is the seat of racial unrest and the precursor to civil war. For example: The success of England becoming a united nation of Anglo-Saxons and Normans, despite civil unrest, is scarred today by the disunity of Scotland, Wales and Ireland who cannot meld to become one – the people of Great Britain.
