We now need to have an answer for the following questions:

- 1. In a nutshell: "What is blasphemy?" (It must cover all possibilities)
- 2. Is there any difference between blasphemy and taking the Lord's name in vain?
- 3. How do we check that we don't blaspheme?
- 4. How to we respond to others who blaspheme?
- 5. What really is "blasphemy against the Holy Spirit"?

The above questions will be answered in discussion at Forerunners next month and that will finalize the challenge.

IMPORTANT: This challenge was given to everyone to investigate. It's not up to me to check and correct what we are told from the pulpit – every believer is responsible. None of us will be able to say to the Judge on the day of Judgement, "It's not my fault! I wasn't taught the truth." Like the Bereans⁴ we are to check everything. This is done through Bible research and more importantly by discernment (i.e. What does the Spirit say to you about what you just heard/read?) In fact, as Kingdom citizens and sons, our responsibility is to ask Holy Spirit questions so we know what to believe. Remember, Holy Spirit is our teacher⁶ (according to our King) not church leaders or TV preachers, and not even the Bible.
