(AMPC)

To receive the knowledge of life in the Kingdom we must know “The Word” himself.

We must know his voice and be able to hear him on a constant basis.

Listening to his voice is the life-food of the Spirit that’s essential to grow & mature – and to be spiritually prepared.

Our primary allegiance in the Kingdom of God is to our King. Everything we believe must align with his mind. Therefore, it is our responsibility to submit everything to him for confirmation and allow him to teach us.

Religion has no place in the Kingdom



What we find is that those who have come out of the religious system and are learning to live as sons have contrasting revelations to those inside.

Many are being mentored by Jesus himself so they have access to knowledge that is hidden from those who draw from the church, the Bible and the pastor.



Here's what we've discovered, just as the Christian mystics in the past have also learned: Our King will teach us Heavenly wisdom and knowledge that may contradict current understanding.

His knowledge is perfect – ours isn't



For example, from our personal experience:

- A divorcee is shown who his new wife is to be – contradicting biblical divorce 'laws'.
- A Kingdom son is given a European sports car because Father wanted to give him a gift – contradicting the biblical 'law' of self-denial.

**So, what has our Lord been telling us
about eternal punishment?**

Very little!
