

A Short Glossary of Kingdom Terms

This is a brief list of words and expressions that we use when we talk about and teach on the Kingdom. They are not necessarily the same terms that others use, nor are the meanings always the same. The items in this list have come from our insights as we change into functional sons. The reason for this document is to explain our speech as we have shifted from Christian jargon to the reality of the Kingdom.

- God's Original Plan:** The way creation was implemented with Adam and Ezer¹ in the garden east of Eden. This plan has not changed, it is still his intention to see it that way again.
- Rulership:** What we rule over as sons right now.
- Dominion:** Our place of oversight of the Earth which we were endowed with at creation.
- Free Will:** The ability to be free to make our own choices was given to every human being. Our free will is accountable to God for how we use it.
- Autonomy:** The ability to be our 'own person' and not require someone to tell us what to do. This was given to every human being. Sons willingly place this under the oversight of the King.
- Old Covenant:** The blood covenant between Jehovah (The Son) and Israel. This terminated in 70AD with the destruction of the Jerusalem temple and the cessation of the sacrificial system.
- New Covenant:** The covenant made between Father and humanity with the blood of Jesus. This was fully implemented in 70AD and had been in place ever since.
- Religion:** What people do to please God or placate his anger. This can be a system, or an activity done regularly or intermittently. It can also be what God gave instructions to do in the past but which is currently no longer valid.
- Christianity:** The Christian religion which developed during end the 1st century and formalized in the 2nd century. It became Roman Catholicism which forked into the various Orthodox churches and later into Protestantism.
- Christian:** A member of the Christian religion.
- Legalism:** Following a set of laws as a measure of righteousness – e.g. Torah, 10 Commandments.
- Liberty:** Freedom from being controlled by law.
- Freedom:** The absence of bondage, especially to the law.
- The Royal Law:** The 'Law of Love' is one plumb line which guides sons in right behaviours.
- Righteousness:** What is right in God's sight. Not what is legally right or correct.
- Church:** The Latin term used by Christians for the 'house of God'.
- Church System:** Christianity as it functions in the various church organisations.
- Ekklesia:** The Greek term used for the genuine follower's of Jesus.
- The Kingdom Message:** What Jesus and the Apostles spoke about.
- Gospel of the Kingdom** The genuine good news that Jesus and Paul taught. Includes the gospel of peace, the gospel of salvation, and all the other gospels. Actually meant in 1st century Roman culture that there was a new king/emperor on the throne who would maintain the stability and the protection of society.
- Gospel of Salvation:** The message the church system has spread. Focusses on being saved from hell so a person can go to Heaven.
- Kingdom:** The **King's domain** – i.e. a king's territory. Even includes regions where there is rebellion.
- The King:** The ascended man Jesus.
- Kingdom of God:** Where ever God has sovereignty.
- Kingdom of Heaven:** The rulership of God in the spirit realm where he has dominion.
- The Kingdom:** The manifestation of the Kingdom of God on Earth.
- Kingdom Citizens:** The generic term for the people who have come into the Kingdom and are members of it on Earth.
- New Species:** What we become when we are spiritually re-born. We are not like a normal human being.²

- Personal Kingdom:** What you rule over with authority – your body, your surrounds, for family, your possessions, your property, and anywhere else you have spiritual authority.
- Internal Kingdom:** The presence of the King inside us. Where he is allowed to rule on the throne of our heart.
- Throne of the Heart:** Who is in charge of a person’s life. Identified by what their heart longs for and is submitted to.
- Divided Heart:** When there are equal loyalties to the King and something/someone else at the same time.
- ‘Heaven’:** The royal function of the Trinity where their rule is sovereign. Analogous to the ‘court’ where the rule of a king or queen is sovereign, along with their inner circle and their courtiers. Equivalent to “the Crown” (British expression).
- The Trinity:** The 3 separate persons – Father, Son & Holy Spirit. These are individuals with distinct function and able to be related to separately.
- Intimacy:** The type of relationship the Trinity is wanting to have with us. It is a love relationship of openness, honesty and compliance.
- Oneness:** The interpersonal love, mind, attitudes and heart that the Trinity have for each other. Epitomised by newly wed lovers. This is the ultimate desire for the Trinity’s relationship with us.
- Sonship:** Our lives after we are spiritually reborn³ – i.e. living as sons of the Most High God. This is the same relationship Father has with Son (Jesus the man).
- Identity:** Who we really are – i.e. sons of the Most High God.
- Partnering:** Sons working on Earth with and for the purposes of Heaven, through the Kingdom.
- Apprenticeship:** Partnering with the King, under his supervision. Learning how to operate properly sons so we can be released into whatever work he wants us to do.
- Prototype:** The final model that everything else is based on. Jesus was one – viz. the first Spirit-filled human being.
- Journey:** Our development, spiritually and naturally, through life up to the present time under the orchestration of Heaven.
- Processes:** The various situations we are put through in life as part of our molding and shaping so we become the son that Father wants us to be.
- Kingdom Assignment:** An activity we are given by the King for the purposes of the Kingdom. These are times and situations where we are ‘about Father’s business’.
- Maturity:** Growing spiritually and in our sonship. Learning to be a son, priest and king.
- Spiritual:** The things involving our spirit, Holy Spirit and the spirit realm, especially Heaven.
- Spirituality:** Operating out of our spirit rather than our mind, soul or ‘flesh’. The process of our spirit becoming the dominant component of our being.
- Spirit-led:** Being guided and directed by Holy Spirit. Sons have this as one of their highest priorities.
- Administrate:** Confidently handling every situation and circumstance by dealing with it as we are shown by Holy Spirit. Comes with maturity and a high level of trust in our King’s ability to be in charge.
- Community:** What occurs when the members of the ekklesia in a location come together in one accord and in love and honour of each other. Akin to being a spiritual family.
- Kingdom Community:** A community whose life and focus is the Kingdom. Their purpose is to be part of the those who expand the Kingdom into their locality.
- Impact:** The purpose of Kingdom citizens in the world system. This is the light and salt that Heaven uses to transform the Earth.
- Theology:** A person’s understanding of God and his ways.
- Deprogramming:** The removal of all unnecessary and hindering theology by the King. This includes error as well as misconceptions and the misinterpretation of scripture.
- Reprogramming:** The addition of Kingdom knowledge to replace what has been removed. Replacing lies and error with truth and reality.
- Kingdom Knowledge:** Understanding of the Kingdom, Heaven, the Trinity and the spirit realm supplied by Holy Spirit.
- Kingdom Principles:** The spiritual protocols that the Kingdom and the spirit realm operate under. These are the ones that sons need to learn to work with and submit to.
- Eschatology:** A person’s understanding of End Times, whether accurate or inaccurate.

- Preterist:** The eschatology that sees most of prophecy already fulfilled, including Daniel, Joel and Matthew 24. Sees the book of Revelation as a symbolic message to the churches of Asia Minor, not a prophecy of the future.
- Restoration:** Father's plan since The Fall to return his creation to where it originally was. This has been going on ever since The Fall.
- Kingdom Supply:** The source of resources and every need for Kingdom citizens which is provided by Heaven.
- Ascension Gifts:** The advanced functions given to the ekklesia for every one's benefit and their developmental maturity – viz. apostles, prophets, pastors, teachers & evangelists.
- Apostle:** A person with the mantle for leadership and oversight. Their main purpose is to implement Heaven's plans in the ekklesia and the locality. Their focus is finding out what Heaven wants, receiving blueprints for tasks and carrying them out. It is a function, not an office. Apostles are discerned, not elected or inducted.
- Mantle:** An anointing for a Kingdom function – e.g. for the job of being apostolic and undertaking apostolic activities for the Kingdom.
- Apostolic:** To function like an apostle under a specific anointing. The anointing level varies with the Kingdom assignment and with the sphere that a son is to influence.
- Blueprint:** The specific plans Heaven has to be implemented on the Earth.
- Prophet:** A person who operates prophetically at a high level for the purposes of being a voice for Heaven. Their focus is on hearing from Heaven and seeing any information passed on to the ekklesia. This is a function, not an office. They are known by their prophecies – they are not elected or inducted.
- Prophecy:** Any message from the Trinity given to a person for the benefit of others, especially the ekklesia.
- The Word:** An ancient Hebrew concept of the expression of Jehovah to his people. This was revealed to them as The Son who appeared on the natural as the man Jesus of Nazareth, their Messiah.⁴
- The Body:** An ekklesia community who function like an organism, not an organisation. Each person has a function and operates in it for the benefit of the whole.
- The Bride:** The members of the ekklesia worldwide. This is now, not the future. The true Bride is identified by those who are in intimacy with the King and who have him as their beloved.
- Remnant:** The comparatively small group of those who don't give up doing the pressures of End Times.
- The New Jerusalem:** The living temple organism made up of those who have surrendered themselves completely and who have gone down the path of training. Includes all such sons, past and present.
- Living Water:** The daily refreshment supplied by the King through Holy Spirit. This is essential to be able to function during the trials and tests of sonship.
- Righteous:** What is right as far as the Trinity is concerned regarding our speech, actions and attitudes.
- Sin:** Anything said, thought or done which is not in alignment with the Trinity's wishes or plans. It includes what is not performed through faith.⁵
- Insurgence:** The impact of the Kingdom citizens during the 1st century which changed systems and nations. This insurrection against the world system and the Kingdom of Darkness needs to continue today, both covertly and overtly, as led by Holy Spirit.
- Seven Mountains:** The most influential domains of society that must see insurgency so that the Kingdom spreads – (1) Spiritual; (2) Family; (3) Government & military; (4) Economy & business; (5) Education; (6) Arts, sports & culture; (7) Media & entertainment.
- Church Age:** The period of time from the 1st century until today.
- Kingdom Age:** The period of time from the reintroduction of the importance of the Kingdom until the end of all things – i.e. today.
- The New Era:** What the King is doing that is new from now on. The focus is the manifestation of genuine sonship and the restoration of all things.
- Edification:** What is required to mature the members of the ekklesia.
- Service:** What sons do for others.
- Servant:** How sons operate in relation to others.

- Bond Servant:** How sons operate in relation to others because they choose to surrender control of their lives to the King whom they love.
- Preaching:** Instruction about the Kingdom given to non-believers.
- Teaching:** Instruction given to members of the ekklesia.
- Sound Teaching:** Accurate instruction in line with the Kingdom given to members of the ekklesia.
- Truth:** Whatever is a reality as far as the Trinity is concerned. The opposite of error.
- Error:** A false belief that differs from the reality of the Kingdom and the spiritual realm.
- Heresy:** Any belief, truth or error, which causes a split in the harmony of a local ekklesia.
- Deception:** To be deceived into believing a lie or an error. A person in deception doesn't know they are deceived because that's what deception is.
- Headship:** The position of King Jesus as the head of the ekklesia.
- Leadership:** What Holy Spirit does for sons and for the ekklesia.
- Overseer:** Those set in place by the King to look after and watch over a local ekklesia. This is not an office.
- Oversight:** What overseers do in keeping watch over a local ekklesia.
- Elder:** Mature aged and spiritually mature men who are set in place by the King as overseers.
- Plural Eldership:** The group of overseers for a local ekklesia so that all the ascension gifts are functioning.
- False Oversight:** A person or persons placed in a position of overseeing others when that was not authorized by the King. Includes telling others what to do and believe, when this is the prerogative of the King, not a person. Also includes wanting or forcing society to live up to Christian standards ('allotriepiskopos'⁶).
- Worship:** Whatever is done to show the worth-ship (worthiness) of the members of the Trinity.
- Love:** Specifically, the powerful type of love that only the Trinity has. Not any kind of human love. Not even agapē. Can only be supplied to a person by Holy Spirit.
- Spirit Communication:** The normal 24/7 spirit-to-Spirit communication which Kingdom citizens have with the Trinity.
- Righteous Pleasure:** Pleasure derived from being in Father's love. Also, the fulfilment of the person in their Kingdom functioning.
- Favour:** Special privileges and blessing given to all Kingdom citizens because they are part of the Kingdom.
- Authority:** The rights a person has over others. Needs to be in line with society's principals.
- Spiritual Authority:** The rights a person has over others and over members of the spiritual realm. Needs to be in line with Kingdom principals.
- Spiritual Warfare:** The war sons have on a constant basis with the Kingdom of Darkness. The basic weapon of this is resistance.
- Home:** Earth is our home, not Heaven. We were design for it and created to rule Earth for Father. This role has not changed.
- Real Self:** Our spirit, not our physical person.
- Paradigm:** A highly significant pattern or model of what we believe to be true. These can be falsehoods or truths.
- Paradigm Shift:** A change in one of the paradigms a person subscribes to. Caused by a change in approach or underlying assumptions.
