Matthew	5	31	10
Mark	15	0	1
Luke	32	0	3
John	2	0	0

NOTE: The terms are interchangeable

Statements:

John The Baptist



In those days there appeared John the Baptist, preaching in the Wilderness (Desert) of Judea and saying, repent (**think differently; change your mind...**), for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew 3:1-2 (AMPC)

“The law and the prophets were until John. Since that time the kingdom of God has been preached, and everyone is pressing into it.

Luke 16:16 (NKJV)

And from the days of John the Baptist until the present time, the kingdom of heaven has endured violent assault, and violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize—a share in the heavenly kingdom is sought with most ardent zeal and intense exertion].

Matthew 11:12 (AMPC)

Statements:

Jesus

...“I must preach the kingdom of God
to the other cities also, because for
this purpose I have been sent.”

Luke 4:43 (NKJV)



Now after John was put in prison,
Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the
gospel of the kingdom of God

Mark 1:14 (NKJV)



It was after John's arrest that Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the Gospel of God, saying, "The time has come at last—the kingdom of God has arrived. You must **change your hearts and minds and believe the good news.**"

Mark 1:15 (PHILLIPS)

And Jesus went about all Galilee,
teaching in their synagogues,
preaching the gospel of the kingdom,
and healing all kinds of sickness and
all kinds of disease among the people.

Matthew 4:23 (NKJV)

But seek first the kingdom of God and
His righteousness, and all these
things shall be added to you.

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 9:35 (NKJV)

But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of healing.

Luke 9:11 (NKJV)



He **sent them** to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Luke 9:2 (NKJV)

...you must go into the streets and say, 'We brush off even the dust of your town from our feet as a protest against you. But it is still true that the kingdom of God **has arrived!**

Luke 10:11 (PHILLIPS)

“Do not fear, little flock, for it is your
Father’s good pleasure to give you the
kingdom.”

Luke 12:32 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, “Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God.”

Luke 9:60 (NKJV)

But Jesus said to him, “No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.”

Luke 9:62 (NKJV)

But if it is by the Spirit of God that I
cast out the demons, then the
kingdom of God has come upon you
[before you expected it].

Matthew 12:28 (AMP)

And He said to them, “To you it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables,

Mark 4:11 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Sower]

When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside.

Matthew 13:19 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Wheat and the Tares]

Another parable He put forth to them, saying: “The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field;

Matthew 13:24 (NKJV)



The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one.

Matthew 13:38 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Mustard Seed]

Then He said, “To what shall we liken the kingdom of God? Or with what parable shall we picture it?”

Mark 4:30 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Growing Seed]

And He said, “The kingdom of God is
as if a man should scatter seed on the
ground,

Mark 4:26 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Leaven]

Another parable He spoke to them:
“The kingdom of heaven is like leaven,
which a woman took and hid in three
measures of meal till it was all
leavened.”

Matthew 13:33 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Hidden Treasure]

“Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Matthew 13:44 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Pearl of Great Price]

“Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls,

Matthew 13:45 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Dragnet]

“Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet that was cast into the sea and gathered some of every kind,

Matthew 13:47 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Vineyard Workers]

“For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard.

Matthew 20:1 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Wise & Foolish Virgins]

“Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom.

Matthew 25:1 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Talents]

“For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them.

Matthew 25:14 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Wedding Feast]

“The kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who arranged a marriage for his son,

Matthew 22:2 (NKJV)

[The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant]

Therefore the kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants.

Matthew 18:23 (NKJV)

Blessed are you poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.

Luke 6:20 (NKJV)

Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:19 (NKJV)

For I say to you, that unless your
righteousness exceeds the
righteousness of the scribes and
Pharisees, you will by no means enter
the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:20 (NKJV)

Then He said to them, “Therefore every scribe instructed concerning the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out of his treasure things new and old.”

Matthew 13:52 (NKJV)

And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

Matthew 16:19 (NKJV)

...“Let the little children come to Me,
and do not forbid them; for of such is
the kingdom of God.”

Mark 10:14 (NKJV)

Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it.

Mark 10:15 (NKJV)

...and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He who is able to accept it, let him accept it.”

Matthew 19:12 (NKJV)

But Jesus said, “Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven.”

Matthew 19:14 (NKJV)

... “How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!”

Mark 10:23 (NKJV)

And if your eye causes you to sin,
pluck it out. It is better for you to enter
the kingdom of God with one eye,
rather than having two eyes, to be
cast into hell fire

Mark 9:47 (NKJV)

...“You are not far from the kingdom of God”...

Mark 12:34 (NKJV)

...Jesus said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you that tax collectors and harlots enter the kingdom of God before you.

Matthew 21:31 (NKJV)



“Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.

Matthew 21:43 (NKJV)

But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in.

Matthew 23:13 (NKJV)

Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

John 3:5 (NKJV)



Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Matthew 25:34 (NKJV)



And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

Matthew 24:14 (NKJV)



[Jesus' Transfiguration]

And He said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the kingdom of God present with power.”

Mark 9:1 (NKJV)



...being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

Acts 1:3 (NKJV)

Everything Jesus said, did or became was about '**The Kingdom**' – the Kingdom of God (also known as the Kingdom of Heaven).

He was endeavouring to school every one he met about this pre-eminent institution of his Father.

Check this out:

Our Father in Heaven, we honor your holy name. We ask that your Kingdom will come now. May your will be done here on earth, just as it is in Heaven.

Matthew 6:9b-10 (TLB)

In his model prayer, Jesus demonstrated to his disciples that after acknowledging Father God, the next priority to focus on is '**The Kingdom**'.

Apostles

But when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

Acts 8:12 (NKJV)

And [Paul] went into the synagogue
and spoke boldly for three months,
reasoning and persuading concerning
the things of the kingdom of God.

Acts 19:8 (NKJV)

“And indeed, now I know that you all,
among whom I have gone preaching
the kingdom of God, will see my face
no more.

Acts 20:25 (NKJV)

...many came to [Paul] at his lodging,
to whom he explained and solemnly
testified of the kingdom of God,
persuading them concerning Jesus...

Acts 28:23 (NKJV)

Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.

Acts 28:30-31 (NKJV)



I, John, both your brother and
companion in the tribulation and
kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ,
was on the island that is called Patmos

Revelation 1:9 (NKJV)

**So, the Apostles
carried on the message
of the Kingdom**

But it got lost

However, **'The Kingdom'**
is the focus of Heaven
and the most important
topic in the universe



You must get this!

Jesus didn't come
to start a new religion

He came to bring people
back into Father's Kingdom
