Learning to Operate as a Son Should Function

I was brought in the church system under the paradigm that you have to ask God for everything - i.e. you have to pray for all of your needs. This teaching is based on the scripture, "you do not have because you do not ask"¹.

In the Kingdom we're learning that we are to operate in different ways to the one above. For example, the Kingdom supplies our needs because Father already knows what we need² and when we push forward <u>in</u> <u>reliance on his Kingdom</u> our needs are met without us having to make a request.³ This is how I'm living my life now and it's causing Christians I converse with to think I'm a 'heretic' because I don't spent a large part of my day in intercessory prayer.

So, for me, to be shown that I must stop asking for things every morning – things I need so I can function rightly as a son – it's been a scary time wondering if my sonship needs will be supplied.

Some of the things I stopped asking for each day was the supply of: teaching, inspiration, revelation, downloads, and prophetic messages.

What's happened since I stopped?

<u>Revelations are coming thick and fast</u>. So fast that I'm writing a teaching article almost every day. These are teachings on new topics as well as teachings needed to reprogram us.

Interestingly, as I analyse situations and what people say I'm given Heaven's response to them. This provides additional teaching and reprogramming. I haven't needed to ask for our King's perspective on things, he just gives them to me. Now this isn't everything that happens to me each day, only various events and situations he wants to give me a Kingdom understanding on.

This means that you will most likely receive teaching on something you said, wrote and expressed allegiance to.

Please don't receive such teaching as criticism. Because things are put out in community, everyone needs to have Heaven's perspective on them so we don't get off track. This is the reason for Jesus' rebuke of the two groups in the second chapter of Revelation – they didn't correct and eliminate error which resulted in it spreading through the group.

In addition to plenty of downloads, I'm getting what I need to present at each gathering when I get there with everyone. I'm provided with teaching to prepare during the week, but as to what I actually present, it becomes obvious during the gathering. I no longer have to ask to be shown what to share and teach on. I just turn up, make myself available, and the itinerary is shown to me. I no longer try to squeeze in everything I've brought with me.
