

How I Wasted My Time and Energy in the Past

[A transcription of a recording of my presentation of this teaching]

In the Kingdom, our time and our energy is to be spent on the King's business, nothing else. While we do that we are fulfilling our role and responsibilities as a son, and out of our sonship will flow all of our Kingdom assignments and our responsibilities in life. Those are the responsibilities we have in the natural, whatever they happens to be – e.g. being a parent, being an employee, running your own business. All these responsibilities are righteous, and provided we are living out of the Internal Kingdom, everything will flow from there so we can manage our personal Kingdom which surround us. This is our focus.

Unlike my time in the church system, my focus now is not on the church organisation and doing religious things, it's different. It's on the King, his Kingdom, my assignments, touching people with the Kingdom, loving those around me, being led into good works, and operation out of his joy and his peace and rest. All these come from my life in the Internal Kingdom.

Focussing on theology (man's ideas about God), whether it's your own personal Bible study or doing a course in theology, is not what's required for a Kingdom citizen, unless Holy Spirit directs you. And, I don't mean that you feel like you ought to do it. I mean, you get a message through your spirit advising you to do it. That's being led by the Spirit, not by your heart, mind and emotions.

I've been teaching for quite some time now on hearing from Heaven. This is how a son functions – 24/7 spirit-to-Spirit communication with the Trinity. That's where our knowledge comes from. That's where our advice comes from. Strategies, blueprints, wisdom, it all comes from our spirit-to-Spirit communication. Trying to find out what you have to do every moment of your life, or how to enter your destiny, any other way than hearing directly from the Throne, will use up a lot of your time. On top of that, it has the very real potential of leading you in the wrong direction. Do you recall how Jesus and the Apostles functioned? **They focussed on hearing from the Spirit who told them what to say, what to do, where to go, what to teach and what to write.** We're supposed to be no different. This is the standard operating procedure for sons.

(1) I've spent nearly 30 years on a journey finding that out. Starting from a biblical, Christian point of view, to a point now of being a son, I wasted so much time because I wasn't taught accurately that right back when I was 16 and committed myself to follow the Lord Jesus. If I had've been properly trained right back in the 1960s, I wouldn't 've wasted so much of my life in the search that's led me to where I am today. This is why we need to train, mentor and disciple those who we come into contact, with what we know of the Kingdom and how to live in it. We can't afford to abrogate our responsibility and release people to the church system for their training, and then have to reprogram them. We don't want to waste their time. All time misspent is time spent outside of the abundant life of the Kingdom.

(2) Another area where I wasted a lot of my time (and I notice so many others are also doing today) is biblical prophesy. For them, as it was for me, it's trying to find out what's ahead of us – foretelling as it's called. This is primarily trying to uncover what's going to happen in End Times, and it's usually taken from the book of Daniel, Matthew 24, and the book of Revelation. From my studies called 'Re-evaluating the Book of Revelation', we have discovered that there is no firm interpretation of The End in scripture. There are multiple understandings, and if there are many, it's not plain. So, any belief that we have is man-made – the teachings of men.

The only source of what's ahead of us is the King himself. As I've been urging you, ask him and find out what you need to know. Bear in mind that he's not interested in your being focussed on the very end, so if you ask him about it, you may not get anything. This is because he wants you to focus on the here-&-now – what he's doing with you, and what he wants to do with you.

All our energy and all our time is to be focussed on our Kingdom assignments, our responsibilities as Kingdom citizens, our family and the workplace.

Leave the future in Father's hands. The way he works is to let us know, either personally or through the prophets, what's ahead. However, he'll only let us know what we need to know, because we get distracted very easily, especially because of the influence of fear. If your history is correct, you'll realise that Jesus of Nazareth spoke to his disciples and said, "When you see the city surrounded, get out of there quick. Don't even go back and get your things. Head for the hills."¹ That's exactly what happened about 40 years later when the Romans surrounded Jerusalem to sack it. The army withdrew for a time because there was trouble back in Rome. As soon as they left, every single believer evacuated and headed for the mountains of Pella and were saved.² Josephus confirms that in his recorded history of the Jews of that day,³ as did Eusebius.⁴

The moral to be taken from this incident: Let the Spirit tell you what you need to know and when he does, follow his instructions 'to the letter'.

So, don't waste your time(e.g. in biblical prophecy). Focus on what's important. You must operate as a son, 24/7, putting all your time and energy into that. If you do, and do it properly, you won't neglect your duties and responsibilities. If you draw from the Internal Kingdom, from the life of the Spirit, you'll be energised, refreshed and stabilized to function properly every day. This will bring joy, rest and peace, because when you submit to Father overseeing your entire life and you work in partnership with him, aligning with his plans, everything works out.
