I'm Drawing Life From the King

I'm continuing to make advances in the Kingdom life that I'm living. I'm experiencing what Paul called "the life of Christ" who is now living his life in me and through me, only because I've invited him to and practise it to reprogram by body.¹ This is the reality of the Internal Kingdom. The Spirit lives in me and I draw from that life.²

My time in the morning of drinking of the Living Water³ and feasting on the Living Bread⁴ has become drawing life (abundant life⁵) from the Internal Kingdom.⁶ This refreshes me and energizes me for the day as you would expect from bread and water. It also stabilizes me and focusses me for the day – keeps my mind on the King and the Kingdom, rather than the issues of my life.

All thoughts of Living Water and Living Bread are fading and the life of the King is what I'm receiving. This shift from bread and water to life is what it's really all about. Bread and water are allegories (pictures) from the natural which Jesus used to describe an activity in the spirit that we should do as Spiritual beings. This's not a mystery for me any more. Instead, it's a mystical activity (one that's a mystery⁷ to those who don't do it or don't understand it).

By the way, this is the same for the allegory of the blood and body that Jesus referred to. We don't really drink his blood⁸ or eat his body⁹.¹⁰ It's an allegory about spiritual life so we can have 'scaffold' to build an understanding on. The upshot of drawing from the life inside my Internal Kingdom is that I'm noticeably changing. I'm finding that I'm now more even-keeled and able to more easily rest and relax because his life is meeting all my emotional needs, the very thing that causes people everywhere to be unstable (you know what I'm referring to).
