Even Now I'm Battling with Religion

This is an update on Report #5.

As I step out and do things, I'm having to do it in real faith and trust. That's trusting that I'm not deviating from the way a son is supposed to function and trusting that, if I do, my Father will alert me and draw me back in line with him before I cause myself major spiritual damage.

One thing I've identified in my experiment in not speaking to the members of the Trinity by name is this: Religion is what a person does or says because they 'feel' like they're not getting through to Heaven. It's like there's a ceiling of brass¹ between me and Heaven, rather than the delight of an open Heaven.

What I found when I continued to talk with the Trinity spirit-to-spirit without addressing them was that I wasn't getting the usual emotional sensation or spirit manifestation that I was connecting with them.

I reverted back one morning and was able to again sense that I was connected. That was a test, so I need to check over time to see if I make spiritual progress without it.

The pull to revert back to feeling something tangible, rather than normal 'emptiness', was very strong. I could sense in my spirit that this is the driving force that keeps people in religion.

I thought about the believers in the first century and how it would have been very easy for them to move from the spirit life into religion because they were in pagan religion before coming into the Kingdom. The sensations they experienced within themselves while in religion would have been the 'solid rock' that they gravitated to as the excitement of experiencing their spiritual life waned over time. I can clearly see how they drifted off and formed the Christian religion by the end of the 1st century.
