

The Mind of a Son Doesn't Come from Reasoning

I've been talking a lot about being reprogrammed, to think as a son should think, not as a Christian thinks. The only way for this to happen is to allow the King to remove all the teaching you've received from the church system that's erroneous and replace it with reality and truth – even removing a lot of what's called biblical truth. This you must be able to do freely and without reserve.

The other way it happens is by 'osmosis' when I'm in his presence. Because I consciously come into his presence every morning and draw life from him, for quite a while, I'm in the right place for me to absorb knowledge through my spirit. I learn a lot this way, but I don't know that I have until I know something in 'my knower' that I haven't known before. It's unusual.

Believe it or not, here's our King advising his listeners of the same thing back in the 1930s:

"...Just come before me and stay awhile in my presence – this must strengthen and help you.

Learn of me. The only way for so many in my poor world to keep calm, sane, is to have the mind which is in Jesus Christ. The mind which is in me.

That mind you can never obtain by reasoning, or by reading, but only by living with me and sharing my life.

*Think much of me. Speak much of me. See others as I see them. Let nothing less satisfy you."*¹
