

Preparing for the ‘Great Christian Civil War’


As I reread parts of Rick Joyner’s ‘The Final Quest Trilogy’ in light of where our King is taking our training these days in the Kingdom, it is quite clear to me that what he was shown is near at hand. I haven’t had a timeline released to me by the Spirit, but it’s a sense that we are moving more and more into a place of opposing juxtaposition for this spiritual war to heat up.

So, what is this civil war?

In the prophetic dreams and visions that Rick Joyner had in the 1990s, he coined the expression the “Great Christian Civil War”¹. This’s because the great Last Days battle between ‘light’ and ‘dark’ will begin with the church (i.e. the majority of the world’s Christians) opposing the committed followers of Jesus. This is not a satisfying thought to contemplate, but it’s the warning message our King gave Rick to write down to prepare his people for it. I believe this warning is needed because we will be disoriented and confused by the attacks in this war and will not be prepared to stand and oppose those we think are our brothers and sisters – it’s not the ‘Christian thing to do’

In teaching article I previously showed what the condition of the saints in this battle will be like.² The purpose of that teaching was to warn my readers to keep a watch on themselves so they don’t become members of the enemy’s army which will be used to war against Jesus’ people.

Here’s what the array of the war will look like with the various types of combatants lined up in it:





The only army regiment that's ready for this war will be the tiny 'Remnant' that our King has been training us to become part of.³ This army is the safest to be in because of the spiritual transformation and training they've received will prepare them for the battles in the war. These sons will be very much like the first Apostles who withstood paganism, Judaism and Rome.

There will be fluid movement between the different spiritual groups as time goes on, including during the war. Wounded saints who aren't healed of their spiritual, emotional and mental injuries will quickly fight against everyone else in the Christian system. Many, many will be captured by the tactics of the enemy.
