

Refuse to Allow Condemnation to get a Foothold

It's vital that we realise that condemnation is a tool of the enemy, just like fear is. As sons who are consecrated, we have the blood of Jesus covering us which 'neutralizes' all condemnation.

The best ways to deal with condemnation is to reject it every time it is heard in our mind. As well as that, judge ourselves and ask for forgiveness every time we sin. This cancels any foothold the enemy can have to accuse us because of the sin and failures in our lives.

Finally, the biggest source of condemnation which we need to 'kill' is religion and legalism. These two work on the fear that we will get into trouble with Almighty God who is too holy for us. It's only by coming out of all religion and being deprogrammed of it, and then reprogrammed in the Kingdom, that we will be free of this BIG source of condemnation.

REMEMBER: Religion and legalism are not foundations of our sonship. They are fakes, created by human beings in an attempt to appease God and to keep us in the religious system.

Our King knows of the burden of condemnation and gives us some good advice:

“Refuse to allow condemnation to dominate your thoughts and actions. This is a work of the carnal nature and of feeling like you don't measure up. When you live and walk in the Spirit it is no longer you who live, but Christ who lives in and through you. Instead of beating yourself up, recognize who you belong to and remember your divine connection and destination.”¹

We all suffer from condemnation from our life's batterings when we didn't measure up to our parents', school teacher's or boss' expectations. We cannot allow these negative feelings to move over into our spiritual life.

IMPORTANT: Father operates out of love and mercy towards us, through grace, in this New Covenant era. Never forget that he's always willing to forgive us and that he desires the best for us. Hang on to those realities. Cling to them and don't let condemnation have any part in your life.
