

Spiritual Hearing Means Getting Answers to Questions

Our spirit-to-Spirit communication is not just about “talking to God” and it’s definitely not about prayer. Spiritual communication is our connection with the Trinity, and as part of their family we’re created to communicate with them. That interaction is about anything and everything. After all, if they want an intimate relationship with each of us which leads to oneness, the more we make our spirit-to-Spirit communication a normal part of our lives, the better it will be for our maturing in sonship.

We must cast off our religious activities (all of them) and move ahead as genuine sons, living in the reality of a personal relationship with each member of the Trinity. Any religious activity which has been devised by Christians, that is not transferable to our Kingdom life, has to go. If we keep them, the religious spirit will continue to have access, enabling it to deviate us back to the religious system. Believe me, that’s the plan of our enemy so we are neutralized.

One area that sons are privileged to have in their 2-way dialogue with the Trinity is getting answers to questions. This is what we do in CCOP¹. Getting answers to questions in my religious days was praying for an answer and expecting it to come somehow or other – I had no idea how. These days I ask questions and wait with my spirit until I get the answer as a download, deposit or a ‘knowing’. Father is always wanting to teach us more and to answer any questions we have because he’s a perfect father to us. He recently reminded us of this feature of our function as sons:

*“To those who are grappling with a difficult problem, remember that you can ask Me and I will give you a solution. I will show you the way. Stand firm on the assurance that I will help you. Do not fret or worry. Silence your inner turmoil so that you can hear My still, small voice.”*²

And also:

*“If you seek Me for wisdom, I will give you perfect solutions to what seem to be difficult problems. In these situations you often forget that you can call on Me for answers. Change your mindset to always look to Me for knowledge and good judgment in every circumstance. I will not disappoint you.”*³

This means no more praying for information. Instead, simply ask a question and wait with your spirit for an answer. If you’re not used to this, start journaling what you ‘think’ you hear and analyze your records over time. You’ll soon learn to hear properly with practice.
