

Kingdom Assignments are Not Meant to Fail

Many times we fail in the things the Spirit sends us off to do or with the word of God he gives us to speak.

BE ADVISED: We are the cause of the failure, not God or the enemy.

To be clear on that, every time there's a failure it's our fault. It wasn't the assignment we were given nor was it the machinations of the enemy. No. We may be able to identify our sins, but we usually think it was a reason other than ourselves why we failed.

Here's what we need to know. Before we are released into an assignment of any size, we are prepared for it. This includes training and experience. Father is a perfect father, and good dads are good teachers. They don't ask their children to do things they can't do.

Father never sets us up to fail.

What happens is that he trains us for the task, but this requires our compliance and full co-operation. Then he may give us a preliminary experience of it before releasing us fully into it. Often we are released so we can be tested. Are we ready for it? What's our faith level? Have we really learnt what we need for the task, or is it just head knowledge or wishful thinking?

Failure in our test, again, is our fault. We weren't ready.

In this case we aren't to give up. Instead we are to surrender to Father for more training and experiencing, and set our heart on achieving what he wants us to be able to do. We are NEVER to condemn ourselves for failure. That's what the enemy does to prevent us from moving forward. What we need to do is forgive ourselves, ask for forgiveness for failing, put it behind us, and concentrate on the new phase of training.

When we are ready, two facets are added to the assignment. These are: Everything is supplied; & Heaven backs us to succeed.

When I say "everything is supplied", I mean EVERYTHING. Heaven 'bankrolls' us by supplying everything we need. Whether it's circumstances, timing, finance, resources, etc., it's all supplied. Never forget that.

If you move into an assignment and you don't have everything you need, wait for it, because you're not in perfect alignment with Heaven's plans. At the same time, check with Holy Spirit, as you may need to step out in faith before a component that's missing will materialize. There's countless stories from Kingdom experience which exemplify the 'step of faith' which released the supply. Without Holy Spirit's "Go Ahead", we are moving in foolishness or presumption.

The other thing that's supplied is the grace to achieve what needs to be done or said. 'Grace' means that Heaven is working behind the scene to make it happen. That's either having you capable, or having the circumstances in perfect alignment. We were reminded of this recently by Father:

*"I remind you this day: do not strive but rest your heart in the quietness, and I will do what you cannot. Anxiety and striving are the enemies of your peace. When I give you a task, I give you the grace to accomplish it. **I never lead you into failure or give you a mission only to make you fall.** I will strengthen you in the quiet place and bring my transcendent presence to calm your soul."*¹

Father states that he won't lead us into a situation of failure or have us do something that he knows will fail.

Remember that it's our fault when we fail.

Sons follow the cowboy's rule: 'When you fall off a horse, get straight back on again'. The reason for that is to prevent fear from side-lining us from the task we were assigned. Fear is an extremely efficient tool of the enemy, so never let it prevent you from doing what you know you are to do.
