

The ‘Secret’ Knowledge of the Kingdom

In the Kingdom, we have access to Heaven’s knowledge. Jesus¹ and Paul² called this “secret knowledge” or “mysteries” (from *mustērion* in the Greek). *Mustērion* also means ‘hidden’.³

The secret knowledge we have is the mysteries of the Kingdom and of Heaven. It’s called ‘secret’ because the knowledge we have access to is hidden from those who are outside our heavenly family. This knowledge is ours to know because we are Father's sons, and it comes because we have all of his family’s rights and privileges.

These are not secrets that a sect, secret society (e.g Mason's) or Wicca might have and protect so they hide them. We don't need secret codes, symbols, terms or anything like that. Ours are freely available once we are adopted back into Father’s family. It’s free and simply understood – it’s not complex requiring high intelligence to decipher it.

It’s there for us to access, any time, all of the time.
