

Time to Reflect on Your Recent Journey

I have been led to reflect on my spiritual journey in recent times and also over the years. I was led by the Spirit who dropped pointers in my spirit which I followed.¹ I was surprised at what I was shown. Even the outcomes of a couple of huge disappointments were revealed to me as beneficially important in the way I function in my Kingdom assignments these days.²

This is the time where many will shout of My goodness, for they will look back on the process I have led them through and the path I have led them on, and they will see My goodness in every step—for in every step...

I see the end from the beginning, and those that trust Me and the path I have prepared for them will look back and see how I used every season and every detail for their good, to bring them to the place I have now positioned and prepared them to step into...

I search the heart and I am looking for those who sing of My goodness in every season. I have never promised a trouble-free path, and actually warned that in this world there would be trouble, but those who truly know Me and My ways are steadfast in their knowledge that I am good. They speak of My goodness even in the midst of trials, for they know I am faithful to fulfill all I have promised. They trust the path I have prepared for them, and they know I am for them and am working all things together for their good.”³

In the times ahead we’ll have to see the goodness in the darkness so we maintain ourselves on our Kingdom journey.

Remember: Almighty God, whose family we belong to, inhabits the darkness.⁴ He created it.⁵ There’s even treasures in darkness.⁶ Therefore, we should have no fear of any darkness.
