

Testing has Past and Future Components

Testing is an important part of being a son. Jesus was tested, so there's no reason to expect that it'll be any different for us.

Testing is to see whether we've learnt what our King has attempted to teach us. When we pass a test we can be promoted to a new Kingdom assignment or a new level of authority. The purpose of the test is always defined by the King, as is the outcome of our success.

This may be a new concept to you because you weren't taught anything about it. To be clear, then, sons are trained, tested, disciplined, corrected, etc., all as part of our growth and development so we can enter the destiny that Father planned for us.

Testing checks learning from past experiences and leads to a move forward in the future at a time of Father's choosing.

Here's this concept laid out quite clearly in a message from our King:

“Pay attention to subtle reminders of past mistakes or bad judgment calls. Circumstances will come up again as a test to see whether you grasped what you needed to learn. Internal work is the order of the day to bring you to a higher spiritual plateau. Your interaction with this opportunity can easily be missed, so be on high alert and get ready to move forward.”¹

IMPORTANT: The Trinity doesn't tempt us, they test us. There's a difference between these.² We allow ourselves to be tempted by the enemy. Testing is part of our Kingdom training.
