

# We Dance to a Different Tune

Recently, while watching my grandkids dancing to some hip-hop music on YouTube playing on our TV, I was given an insight in my spirit. This is what it was:

Elderly people who don’t like this type of dancing or music or costuming will have a strong feeling of aversion to it in their emotions. They will want to turn away, turn it off and be thoroughly displeased in what they see and hear. They will be comparing the YouTube clip with their own likes in music and dance and will be highly critical of anything that’s different. They will call it noise and jiggling around – that’s the natural way things work with likes and dislikes. The spiritual insight I received was that those in the religious system see us the same way. They compare what we do and say with their activities and beliefs. They will have feelings towards us, like the elderly towards hip-hop, and they will turn away from us because of their feelings and their biases.

We have to take this as an example so we can learn to handle the rejection that’s coming. It will be great and it will be intense. We will be rejected, just like Jesus, by all but those who have received truth
