

You Don't Have to Search for Father's Will for Your Life

A lot of Christians stress over making sure that are in "God's will". This isn't how things happen in the Kingdom – the Kingdom doesn't stress.

In this regard, I've discovered two important principles about life in the Kingdom:

1. Many of the decisions I made in the past as a young man were important in getting me to where I am today. I didn't know it back then, but when I made **righteous** decisions, even though I didn't know whether Father wanted me to or not, they steered me towards my destination. Even making a decision to retrain in a new vocation was correct, even though I made that decision for economic reasons and because it fitted in with my heartfelt desire. Right down to the woman I married, Father was working with me without my knowing it.
2. The Kingdom only operates in trust, rest and relaxation – i.e. PEACE. I've learnt to rest in Father's oversight of my life and, while I'm listening for him to speak to me throughout the day, I try not to stress or be anxious about being in his will.

Refusing to stress and, instead, relaxing and letting Father do what he wants in our lives, while we live life **righteously**, is a novel idea for most evangelical Christians. They are taught that God doesn't like it when they're out of his will, so they try TOO hard to know what his will is. All the time they're missing out on enjoying their life as a son and letting Father oversee everything. I know, I used to do that.

Here's confirmation of what I have come to understand:

*"When your life is in my hands, you don't need to worry about what direction to go. This isn't a game of hide-and-peek. You don't have to search for my will as though you've lost it. You must simply trust. **My choices for your life will prevail, and you will one day see how perfectly I have guided you.** I have chosen you...Never doubt my plans for your life, my child. I make no mistakes. Your earthly father may have failed and forgotten you, but I will never fail or forget you."*¹

*"Circumstances will dictate your best course of action in the days ahead. If you are uncertain and afraid settle yourself in the assurance that I am with you. I know you. I care for you. **Allow Me to bring you through difficulties.**"*²

Time to relax and enjoy our life, fulfilling our responsibilities, and letting the burden of our destiny and "God's will" rest comfortably in Father's wonderful hands.

IMPORTANT: This principle 'blind guidance' doesn't mean that we don't do what the Spirit directs us to do – that would be blatant disobedience. It's that type of disobedience that King Jesus told me was 'defiance' and it is the cause of the hold up of his plans for retaking Earth.³
