

No Tolerance for Strife, Contention and Hatred

This is a very important insight from our King. It's the highlighted section:

*“You have always been set apart or separated for My purposes, but I am doing a further work of separation so that you can more completely fulfill the spiritual work you have been given to do according to My plans for your life. You must rise above everything mundane and fleshly. You can no longer do things that you find to be marginal. You belong totally to Me. You will know that you are ready to rise higher spiritually when you have no tolerance for strife, contention and hatred.”*¹

The corollary² to the highlighted sentence is this:

- A person cannot be raised to a higher level of spirituality in their sonship while ever they operate in strife, contention and hatred or there's a tolerance of these in their life.

How we can operate in these three and not see them as anti-Kingdom, shows how blind we are to the realities of life in the Kingdom and the righteous actions we are to live by as sons.

A sobering instruction for this period of time where there is ideological and relational upheaval in our society.

REMEMBER: Our thoughts, actions and speech are mirrors which display the condition of our heart.
