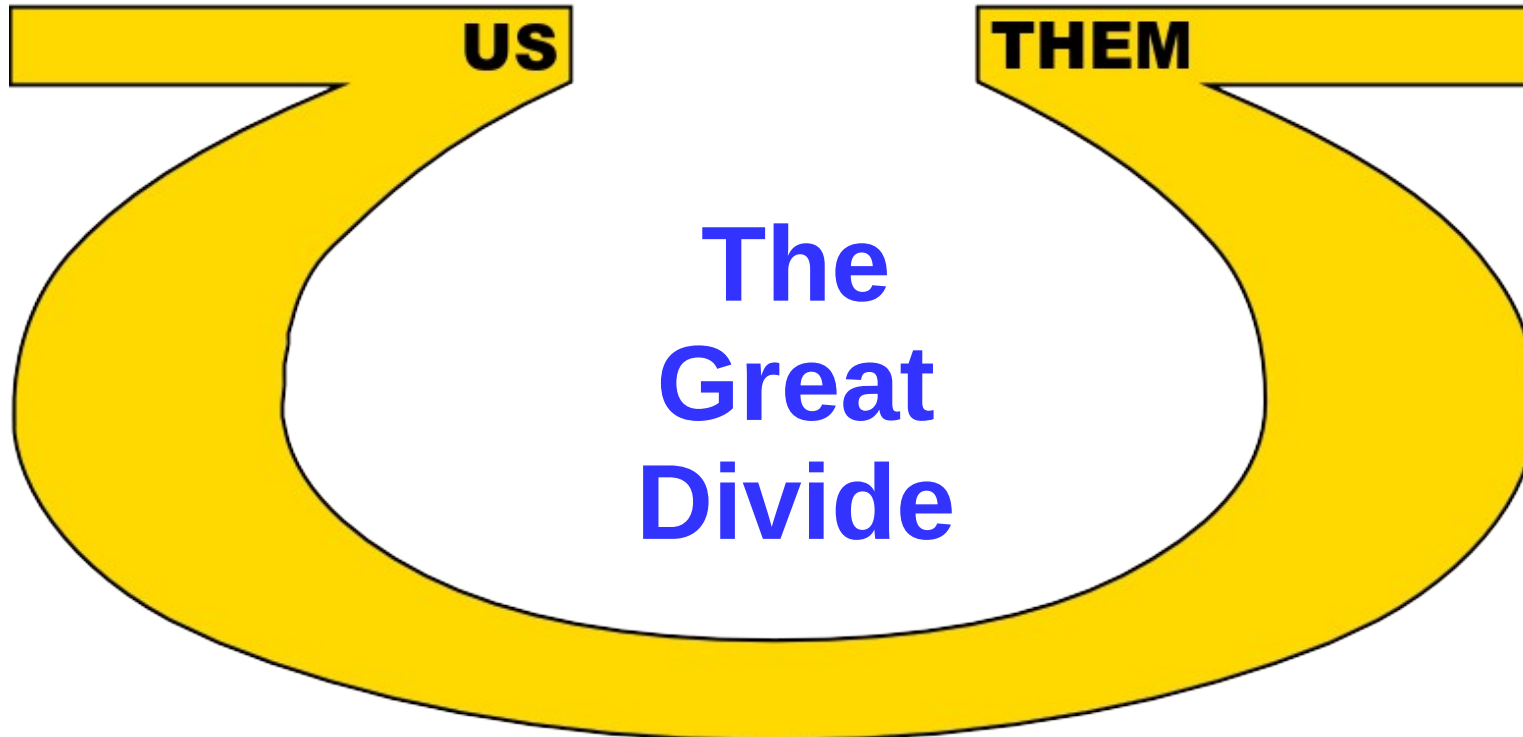

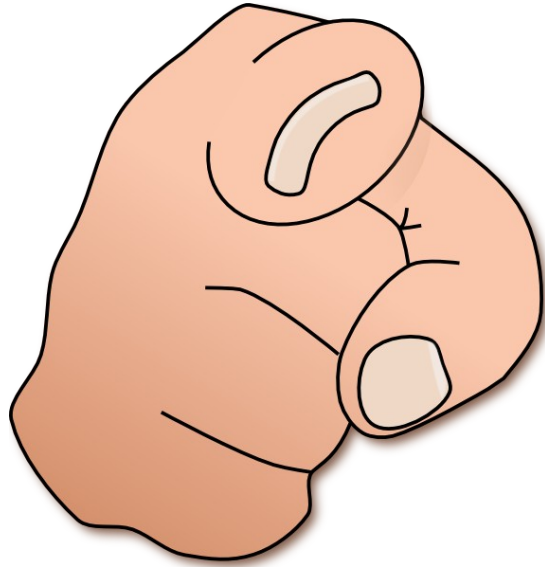
Time to ask more questions about salvation, particularly from the perspective of Father's love.

That will expand our thinking because religion has 'boxed us in' with its dogma of an "angry God".

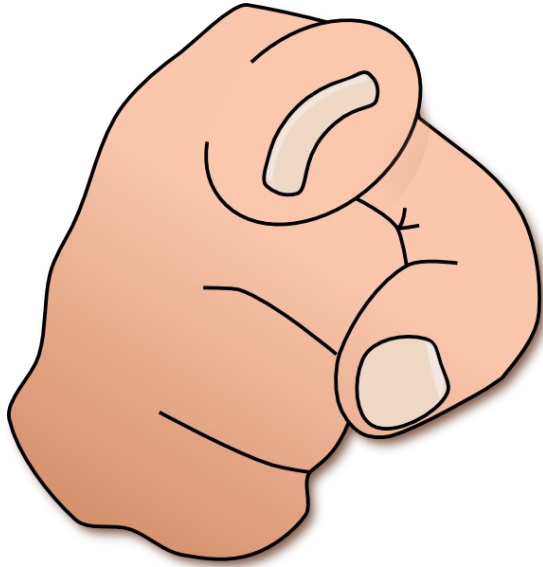
There are so many incongruous bible statements that don't fit this evangelical narrative.

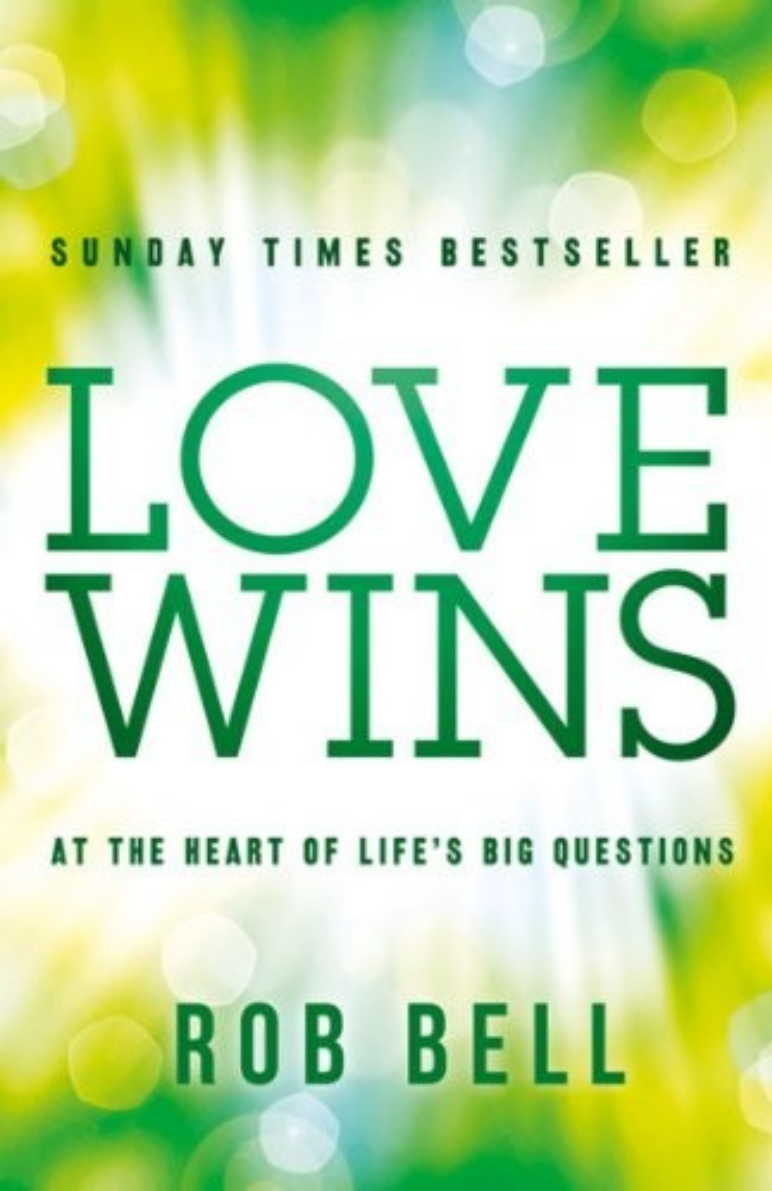

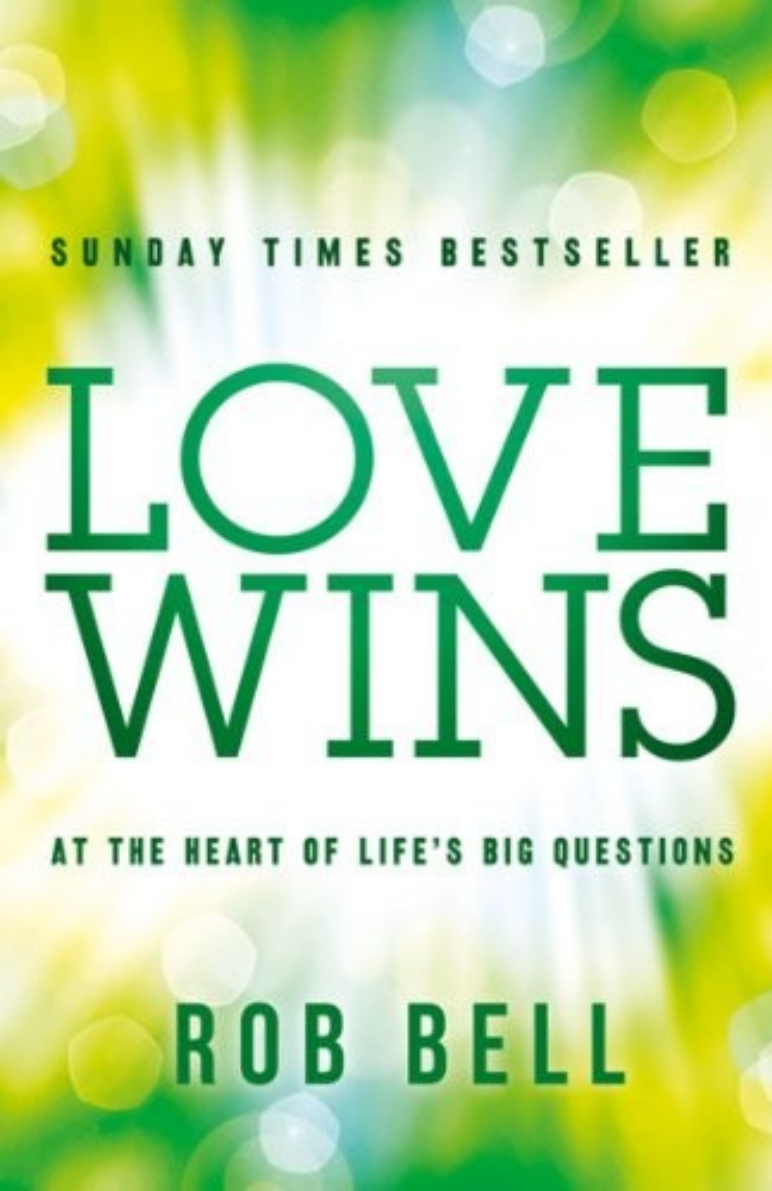

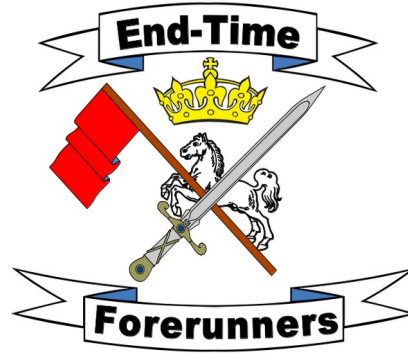
