

Father Never Condemns His Sons

With that in mind, how do we deal with condemnation?

Firstly, identify where it's coming from.

Secondly, entirely reject condemnation in your mind that are thoughts. That's your soul, mind and the enemy condemning you, and it is not justified as far as heaven is concerned.

Thirdly, go into your Internal Kingdom and place any condemnation from people there and let our King handle it.

Fourthly, REST. Let our King deal with it because you've given it to him – even if it was a warranted attack from a person.

Here's Father's mind on this process:

“This very day, my words will mean more to you than anything anyone could ever say. It is in my words that you find life and strength. When you are praised or when you are criticized, come back to me and lay those words before me. Only in my presence will you know truth. If I correct you, it's for your transformation. When I encourage you and display my love, receive it with joy, for it is your strength.

When you feel condemned by others, remember, condemnation doesn't come from me. I never condemn my children. My words are meant to strengthen you and build you. Do not seek the respect of others and thereby forget my words. It is my love you need.”¹
