

Kingdom Ambassadors Also Spread Love and Kindness

We know that ambassadors speak for the head of the country they come from. That includes us as Kingdom ambassadors for the King in this ‘country’ of Earth as we represent the ‘country’ of Heaven.

Ambassadors only speak the mind of the king/president, and so it is with us – we only speak the King’s mind when we speak on his behalf in front of others. Ambassadors have no opinions other than the king’s/president’s when they are in public, and so it is with us – we don’t offer our own opinions when we are representing the King.

All that is sonship “basics 101”.

What we may miss is that when people see us as ambassadors of the King, they should see his character displayed in us because we are his representatives. We won’t represent the King properly if we present ourselves (our character and habits) instead of his character. People won’t get a sense of him, they’ll get a sense of us. This is a big problem for all of us because we allow our souls, minds and bodies to control us rather than the King’s Spirit.

To be genuine ambassadors we must train ourselves to be like him. That’s his request:

“To be My ambassador you must prepare to always spread love and kindness. When you make a determination to do that, you will experience internal adjustments and find a softening of your heart towards others regardless of what they do or don't do. Then, you will reap a harvest of love and kindness from those around you.”¹

You can also see that there’s a benefit for us when we display our King’s character to others. We get changed on the inside where the changes need to be made so we manifest his character on the outside.
