

# We Need to be Whole to Love Correctly

Whatever love we have that we think is Father's love, is not. It is love, but Father's love is very different to what we think it is.

We can say we have agapē love or we can say we have 'sacrificial love', but that's not what Father's love is like in totality. Those are just human, religious terminologies that describe what we give out.

Father's love is so powerful that it can knock you over when you're in his presence. Some who have experienced the gentler side of his love describe it as "liquid love". Can anyone say that others have described the love they received was 'liquid love'? Has anyone been knocked over by the love that we have displayed towards them?

No. We a miles away from loving others as we are loved.

You see, Father's love has to flow through us to others. That's how it works. We can't conjure it up and we shouldn't say that our love is his love.

For his love to perfectly flow through us, we have to be a perfect vessel who's in alignment with him. A perfect vessel has his heart for others. A perfect vessel operates in wholeness, where all hurts, wounds and emotional damages are absent. We don't have to be free of sin or perfect for Father's love to flow through us to others – that's religious thinking. We do have human weaknesses, but we're covered by The Blood and consecrated (holy in Father's sight), so we live out of intimacy with him, basking in his love and allowing him to fill us to overflowing with his love.

*"As you keep your heart before me, allowing me to purify you, you will see change happen that you cannot orchestrate yourself. **When you walk in wholeness, you're able to love with perfect love**—love that expects nothing in return, love that loves without any agenda. Don't rehearse the problems of others, but come in humility, so I can change you. Set love as a torch that burns in your heart, and you will see the restoration of all things. "*<sup>1</sup>

We have a long way to go to love like Father does. That's because we are the problem – we prevent Father's love from flowing through us perfectly.

**But**, don't stop loving others. Keep allowing yourself to be 'cleaned out' of your 'baggage'. Keep allowing yourself to be changed from the inside out. Keep dwelling in intimacy with Father. Progress is made in each of these ways.
