Christians “don’t know to whom the prophecies apply, so they look to the wrong people, in the wrong place, for their fulfillment. Yahweh did not prophesy indiscriminately about everything and everybody. To understand prophecy, you must know to whom the prophecy is addressed.”

Messianic Prophecies Concerning Messiah

These foretold of his virgin birth, the place of his birth, details of what he'd do – healing the sick and the blind, etc. All the details of his betrayal and his crucifixion were supplied, as well as his resurrection on the 3rd day, & more.

Only Jesus clearly fulfilled these.

Prophecies Concerning the 12 Tribes of Israel

The Israelites split into two nations when Solomon died in 975BC. Following that, the two nations (Israel & Judah) had separate histories and different destinies to fulfil.

Either nation alone cannot fulfil the prophecies relating to the whole House of Jacob. Neither can any gentile nation.

Prophecies Concerning Israel (10 tribes)

Breaking away from Judah, this nation had a separate destiny.

Returning from the captivity in Assyria, they were a mixed people from numerous blended nations. The remainder in Assyria eventually blended with the nations around them, ceasing to exist.

Prophecies Concerning Judah (Judah and Benjamin)

These foretold the nation's 70-year captivity in Babylon, the remnant's return to rebuild. It told of the venue for Messiah's arrival and of his sacrifice on the cross.

The 70-weeks foretold by Daniel were fulfilled with the short-lived nation outliving its purpose in 490 years and disappearing from history within one generation. No gentile nation could fulfil its prophetic purposes.

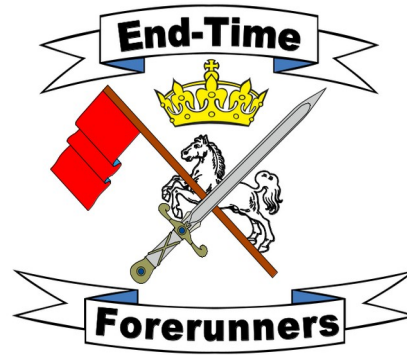
