Don't Limit Yourself

Fear causes us to remain fixed where we're comfortable. It's the fear of the unknown that keeps us from growing and developing in any area of our lives.

This same fear restriction we put on ourselves to remain where we're "happy" to be, will also restrict our growth and development as sons. We may believe 'God' can do anything, and we may also believe that the Spirit will lead us, but we can still remain stuck as a babe in the Kingdom. This is actually my observation of the believers I have met and fellowshipped with – and I still see it. It's not enough to know about the Kingdom, we must strongly desire to be mature in our sonship.

We must identify where we're afraid (fearful) to push beyond the boundaries we limit ourselves with and work on them to get on top of them. Our lives as Kingdom sons and kings requires us to be bold in every area of our lives, and it's in that boldness where genuine faith will be able to shine through.

Father has told us to live the life we have been given 'to the max' and allow him to provide us with the abilities, experiences, skills, favour and blessings to do it. Here's another of his instructions to us to operate that way:

"Do your best with what you have been given. To do that you must focus on what you can do instead of what you cannot do. Know that I will give you abilities far beyond what you believe your limitations to be. Do not be afraid to push yourself beyond the boundaries that you have set for yourself. My Spirit will help you rise above current restrictions to achieve things you never thought possible." ²

Be circumspect about dealing with your limitations. Expand your limits as your are shown by The Spirit and as your own spirit directs you. Expand when it's right and appropriate. Stepping beyond what's advisable leads you into foolishness and presumption.³
