

Know When to Go, Slow or No

I've constantly taught from my own experience, that each of us needs to hear with our spirit because life in the Kingdom is a spiritual existence. As a member of Father's family, he communicates with us Spirit-to-spirit and we communicate in the same way with him.

Contrary to what we're taught, it's not our voice that communicates, it's our spirit that does. When we speak, our spirit communicates the same message (or a better, untainted one) which Holy Spirit picks up.

In this spiritual communication, we must discern¹ so you really know it's the Spirit speaking to us.² That's how we'll know what we're supposed to do, say, go, think and believe. That's one of the basics of sonship in the Kingdom.

One thing we often miss, is the timing and everything else that goes with an instruction. Too often we get the spiritual inspiration to do something or say something, so we jump right in and have a go. Unfortunately, we think we're stepping out in faith, but a lot of the time it's probably presumption. We need to really understand how to step out in faith so we don't mess things up.³

What we forget to do is find out when, where, and how. We also forget to find out how fast or slow we are to move on the inspiration. Everything is vital if we're to align with Heaven and see Heaven's plans come to pass with 100% success.

Here's a reminder to do all this, from our King:

“Many of you, My people, are feeling like you are either half a step ahead or one step behind. Take time to relax and be relieved from stress, and then deliberately position yourself in divine order and in the flow of the Spirit. Then discern when I say go, slow, or no. This is vital at the time for your sense of well being.”⁴
