

# Stability, Decision-making & Spiritual Truth

The 3 items in the heading don't seem to go together. They seem incongruous<sup>1</sup> as far as the Kingdom is concerned. The reason we may think of them like that is because we really don't understand our life in the Kingdom.

You see, the Kingdom isn't an add-on to natural life like religion is – that's the mistake we usually make. The Kingdom is our way of life, both spiritually and naturally. The Kingdom impacts every area of our lives, so we need to begin to see it that way. It's our life – all of it.

There's no separation of spiritual and natural in the Kingdom, as far as the way we partition our lives. The separation of sacred and secular maybe how we see things, but that's not the Kingdom way.

Note Jesus' life, as an example. He was totally committed to Father and re-establishing his Kingdom on the Earth, so there was nothing he did, thought or said that was out of alignment with that. He was a natural man, not a religious leader, even though he operated as a rabbi. He walked and talked with the public; he sailed on boats; he feasted at weddings and special occasions; he spoke to the outcasts of society; and he ate and drank with prostitutes and no-bodies. Read the Gospels closely and his non-religious activities will become quite apparent.

For us, Father is interested in every part of our lives and it's ALL sacred to him. Life is a gift to us because he created it. The natural realm is sacred to him because he created us with a natural body to interact with the natural realm. The problem is that The Fall corrupted everything from its original perfection, but the Kingdom is here to restore it back to where it was.

We can't hate or loath areas of our lives because they don't fit in with our theological concept of sacred and secular. That's contrary to Father's mind on things. Remember, it's our heart that corrupts us, not the realities of the natural realm. Getting married, having children, working in employment, being a corporate professional, etc., are all part of our life in the Kingdom. They aren't evil, substandard or anti-spiritual, only our attitudes and our heart turn them around to be that way in our mind. The Kingdom supplies all our needs, natural and spiritual, so we shouldn't have that dichotomy in our thinking.

Father wants to assist us in managing the affairs of life and his desire for us is to be out there 'boots & all', in the thick of natural life, impacting others with the Kingdom. Our spiritual life is our 'engine' that runs 24/7 and through which we live out of the Internal Kingdom. It's there that we get the strength, energy, love, wisdom, knowledge, etc., to live our lives. All of it brings pleasure to Father, provided our heart is right towards life and towards him.

That brings me to the topic. There's no incongruity with it, because they're all part of living our lives in the natural realm through the Kingdom. Take a moment to hear what Father said to Marsha Burns about it:

*“You have been in a twilight zone, a moment in time of strange space and frame of mind. But do not despair, I will help you find your way to a place where you can stabilize, make good decisions and stand on the solid ground of spiritual truth. Seek My face for possibilities that will define your future. I will guide you.”<sup>2</sup>*
