

# A Deeper Understanding of the Background to Sonship

Religion has caused us to get so much wrong about who we really are and how we're meant to operate as Kingdom sons. Religion has also hidden from us much of the heart and workings of the Trinity towards us, along with what they've achieved and why.

The blog post below outlines some of what's been hidden from us, but which Father is releasing as revelation to those who want to know the truth (i.e. spiritual reality).

Before you read the quote, here's an explanation of some of the terms the author has used in the blog. That will alleviate the possibility that his article is too confusing, causing you to be 'turned off' by his spiritual statements.

- "He/She" – Adam was made in his likeness and image, which means that means he was given the same traits as Father. Adam's traits were divided between himself and Ezer<sup>1</sup> when she was created from his flesh. Therefore, Father has male and female traits combined in his character. However, those terms are what we label them as, they're not terms that relate to him. We could say then, that Father is neuter, because he's a spirit and he doesn't express a sex. Or, we could put a human angle on it and say he's a combination of sexes, like this , but that would be illogical.
- "Life force" – His life is the force that gives life to all living things. It's also the force that keeps the cosmos intact and functioning.
- "Divine intentions" – He is the one whose purposes cause both the cosmos and the spirit realm to function as they do.
- "The energy" – He is light, and those who have met Jesus experience that light. Light is energy. Energy is what holds the atoms, and their subatomic particles together to produce the matter that natural realm is made of. Matter is made of pure energy, as the formula for fission shows:  $e=mc^2$
- "The nature of who you truly are" – We are made in his image and likeness, which means our spirit is like him. We are his sons, so we have deity. That deity is not his level, because he is greater than us. Psalm 8,<sup>2</sup> in the correct translations, declares prophetically that very fact.
- "Elohim" – The term for 'God' and 'gods' in ancient Middle Eastern Semitic languages.<sup>3</sup>

Here's the content of the blog:

*"Many place their Christian theology above Jesus and miss the whole point of what Jesus represents.*

*Jesus came to reveal who you are in the Father and the Father in you. The Father represents more than our definition of an earthly Father. He/She<sup>4</sup> is the life force, the divine intentions, the energy, the nature of who you truly are. To see God outside the box of religion releases divinity to go beyond our indoctrination.*

*Jesus never taught people to exalt Him or worship Him. He taught the opposite. To embrace the love of the Father, to love yourself and to love others. He came to save us from a wrong perspective of ourselves. He didn't come to convince the Father to love us through the shedding of His own blood. His blood was shed because mankind had created a blood thirsty god in their own minds through religion. The wrath of man killed Jesus and the scriptures reveal that God already knew what man would do when they experienced perfect love without rules and regulations.*

*Religion is a self serving tradition that does so out of condemnation and fear. When love confronts it,*
