

A Reminder to Mind Your Own Business

I've written on this topic before,¹ because Father showed me many years ago that it was a very important activity for everyone to engage in. It was also the impetus behind writing my "Spiritual Authority" series,² because those who don't mind their own business have a propensity to overstep spiritual boundaries as busybodies, causing lots of trouble.

In recent times, Father has reminded us to mind our own business. Therefore, even as it's not a spiritual topic that preachers and teachers give training on, Father sees it as vital for sons to think about and to monitor themselves against that troublesome propensity.

Father says:

*"Stay in your lane. You would love to fix everything around you that is out of order or against your code of ethics, but you have no authority to butt in. Remind yourself of your boundaries. You have authority where you have responsibility. **Mind your own business.**"*³

*"There is a fine line between what you can effectively accomplish and what you can do nothing about. Set your heart to do the best you can where you can, and leave the rest to me," says the Lord. "And, **be sure to mind your own business.**"*⁴

*"Simplify and fortify. Refuse to allow your life to become a labyrinth of things that do not concern you. Do not become a worrywart. **Mind your own business** and do the best you can with your own issues of life. Quiet your soul, and strive to establish a place of peace. Seek my face, and come into my presence," says the Lord.*⁵

As Father is repeating himself, it's obvious that his people aren't taking his instructions seriously and constantly, to mind their own business all the time.
