



Under questioning from One Nation Senator Malcolm Roberts during a Senate hearing, members from the Department of Health and Aged Care said the World Health Organisation had no legal authority to force member states to adopt any of its recommendations. "Australia has its own sovereignty in regards to making policy decisions around health for Australians and our borders. I don't think I can be any clearer," Malarndirri McCarthy of the Australian Labor Party, representing the Department, told the Senate

 - "A West Australian landholder accused of breaching the state's Aboriginal heritage laws wants cultural sites recorded on property titles alongside other conditions to alert owners to their existence. Tony Maddox has been charged with damaging a site associated with the Rainbow Serpent, known as a Wagyl to the region's Noongar people, when he built a crossing over a tributary of the Avon River on his property near Toodyay, east of Perth. The 71-year-old could be jailed for nine months or face a

\$20,000 fine if convicted. During his trial in the Perth Magistrates Court this week, Mr Maddox said he bought the property in 2013 and checked all conditions on the property with the shire, through a settlement agent, and on the property title."
