

- ★ "90 Percent of Indigenous People Did Not Vote in South Australia's Voice Referendum"

 "In South Australia, 90 percent of approximately 30,000 eligible Indigenous voters chose not to cast a ballot in the state's Voice referendum on March 16, where voting was not compulsory. Additionally, more than 64 percent of all South Australians rejected a national Voice to Parliament, the second highest "no" majority in the federal referendum in October 2023. Despite this, the state government has allocated \$10.3 million (US\$6.7 million) over four years for the Voice, including \$6.1 million to establish and support ongoing operations and \$4.2 million to conduct the first two elections. Only Indigenous people were eligible to vote in the SA Voice election and only Indigenous people were permitted to nominate."

 Aboriginal Corporation (BNTAC)."

"Nurses and Midwives to Prescribe Abortion Drugs in Queensland"

"The Australian state of Queensland has passed a law that will allow nurses and midwives to prescribe the abortion drug MS-2 Step. Traditionally, obtaining a prescription for the drug in Australia requires a doctor's approval. The drug, MS-2 Step, can be used to terminate a pregnancy up to 63 days from

gestation. Under the new law, the Queensland government is allowing more health workers to provide the drug to pregnant women."

"Australian Bank Closes 45 Branches to Become Digital Only"

"Bankwest will become a digital-only bank, closing 45 branches in Western Australia and transitioning 15 to Commonwealth Bank of Australia (CBA) branches. The bank is planning to convert to a digital bank completely by October 2024, closing or converting all the remaining bank branches it operates in Australia. Explaining the change, the bank claimed 97 percent of transactions are now completed digitally and only two percent of customers visit a branch."

• "Take a Leaf out of NZ's Book: How We Could Deal With the Worker Shortage"

"New research from the Institute of Public Affairs found that, while New Zealand and Australia both experienced a COVID-related spike in job vacancies between 2019 and 2021, only Australia has not recovered. The research shows that New Zealand's job vacancies in 2023 were only 5.4 percent above what they were in 2019, whilst Australia remained 77 percent above 2019 levels. Rather than rely on

migration to fill job vacancies—net migration to New Zealand was half that of Australia's on a per capita basis—the NZ government was the beneficiary of a higher labour force participation rate."
