

- Live Sheep Trade: "Radical' plan to ban controversial Australian industry by 2028"
 - "The controversial live sheep export trade will be banned by the Australian Government from May 1, 2028 but farmers groups and political opponents have hit out at the plan labelling it as "radical" and vowing to undo the move. The Albanese government announced on Saturday it was funding a \$107 million package over four years to help farmers transition out of the industry after it pledged to end the practice amid animal welfare concerns. Agriculture Minister Murray Watt announced the live sheep export trade by sea would end after releasing a report that made 28 recommendations about how to wind down the system."

CSIRO is targeting a \$3.8 billion (US\$2.5 billion) market in the health and wellness industry with this new product."

 - "A federal government official has been found liable under Northern Territory (NT) law for damage to a sacred Indigenous site, in a decision that could set a precedent for how sacred sites are protected. The case centred around damage allegedly caused by Parks Australia while building a walkway close to a sacred men's site near Gunlom Falls in Kakadu National Park in 2019. The cascading waterfall appeared in the movie "Crocodile Dundee." Parks Australia apologised and agreed to redirect the track away from the sacred site, but the Aboriginal Areas Protection Authority wanted to establish criminal accountability... However, Parks Australia successfully argued it was a Commonwealth entity and, therefore, protected, and the court ruled it couldn't be held legally responsible for the damage under Territory law. The Authority then appealed."

The protests come after the Australian Senate passed the Digital ID Bill in late March, with support from senators from the centre-left Labor Party, the Australian Greens, Jacqui Lambie, and independents. The bill establishes a legislative framework for Australians to start using the new program that can help with identity verification with both government and businesses. It will work in conjunction with the MyGov platform that already links to government services like Centrelink, Medicare, and the Australian Tax Office."

• "\$33 Million Transferred From Big Pharma to Doctors in Australia"

"Pharmaceutical companies paid doctors more than \$33 million (US\$21.9 million) over three years in Australia to promote their products. More than 6,500 doctors across the country received at least one payment from a pharmaceutical company between November 2019 and October 2022. The findings were revealed in a peer-reviewed paper published in the Medical Journal of Australia on May 6."

"Australian Plant-Based Meat Sales Surge 47 Percent Between 2020 and 2023"

"Australia's plant-based meat sales surged 47 percent, while per capita consumption increased 28 percent, between 2020 and 2024, according to Food Frontier in its State of the Industry report. The report evaluated the current state of the plant-based meat manufacturing industry, reflecting its economic contributions, and potential future. According to Deloitte Access Economics, total plant-based meat sales reached \$272.5 million (US\$178.94 million) last year. This is equivalent to a compound average growth rate (CAGR) of 14 percent since the 2020 financial year."

• "Why Is Australia Going After Elon Musk?"

"Elon Musk is battling against foreign censorship amid pressure from Brazil and Australia, both of which are trying to extend their censorship laws internationally. Meanwhile, a bill that will ban TikTok unless its parent company sells it before Jan. 19, 2025, has now been enacted. President Joe Biden

signed the bill on April 24 after the Senate passed it in a 70 to 18 vote.
