A hallmark of the Kingdom is considering others over one's self. This is not easy to take completely on-board, but it is how we're meant to operate. Father has reminded us of this recently:

“Beloved, when circumstances require your energy and attention, you must still be aware of the impact you have on others. Do not lose yourself in the process of attending to worldly concerns. In these days it is of even more importance to maintain connection with Me. Stay focused.”¹

Father's extremely conscious (if I can put it that way) of how the things he does impacts us and every one else on the planet. That's because his type of love takes that into account and makes it an imperative. As we learn to take on more of his character, that facet of caring for others, needs to become very important to each of us.
